The District/School Field Advisers are our technical persons in the field. They are the one's implementing the Girl Scout Programs and Trainings in their respective Districts.




They shall meet once a month, every second Saturday to discuss relevant girl scout issues and activities, submit their reports, register/re-register troops and District/Barangay Committee.


