My name is Sheena Marie E. Lao, and I am humbly writing to you to ask for financial assistance for my mother, Imelda E. Lao, Principal of San Jose Elementary School's, hospital bills. She is currently admitted in COOP hospital due to some complications.

Last October 2016, she was examined with having an ovarian cancer in Perpetual Succour Hospital in Cebu City. She has undergone three chemotherapy sessions the same year. Thus January of this year the doctor said that she needs to undergo an operation by the next month. However, we decided to cancel the operation due to financial reasons.
