SUBJECT : PROVINCIAL JUNIOR, SENIOR, AND CADET CAMP

DATE : FEBRUARY 26, 2019

The Bohol Girl Scout Council is pleased to announce that the **Provincial Junior, Senior, and Cadet Camp** to be hosted by Mabini District will be held on **March 22-24, 2019** at the **Mabini Camping Center in Barangay Poblacion, Mabini, Bohol**. The camp theme is *"Commitment @ 70: Engaging Communities, Improving Lives"*.

Pertinent details of the provincial camp are as follows:

Participants

- Junior - Girls: Minimum of Two (2) Patrols and Maximum of Three (3) Patrols per District
- Adult/Troop Leaders: Two (2) per Patrol
- Senior/Cadet - Girls: Minimum of Two (2) Patrols and Maximum of Three (3) Patrols per District
- Adult/Troop Leaders: Two (2) per District

Camp Fee and Inclusions

Six Hundred Fifty Pesos (P650.00) per camper to cover for program materials, badges, souvenir bag, event t-shirt, and tour.

Camp registration fee, and transportation/travelling expenses of the delegates may be charged against Division/School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), District share of SMFC tickets, local and other sources of fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Confirmation and Pre-Registration of Campers

Confirmation and pre-registration of campers is **on or before March 16, 2019**.

Slots of districts who will not confirm on the deadline will be given as additional slot to other districts interested to send more girls.

Qualifications of Campers

- Girls**
- Must be registered Junior, Senior and Cadet Girl Scout as of April 30, 2019
 - Must be physically fit and alert as certified by a licensed physician
 - Must have earned at least one (1) badge under the Eight-Point Challenge
 - Must have attended troop/district camps
- Adults**
- Must be registered Troop Leader as of April 30, 2019
 - Must be physically fit to undergo the rigor of outdoor life
 - Must know and understand her girls
 - Must know the basics of First Aid
 - Must have attended the Basic Course and Outdoor Leadership Course

Participants must be screened and be given the needed pre-camp training during Girl Scouting time on Fridays.

Activities

The campers will experience the following exciting and fun filled activities:

Dancing, Handcraft, Obstacle Games, Sessions on WAGGGS Special Programs, Tour, Food Fest, Songs and Cheers, Chum Hunting, Scouts Own, and Campfire.

The campers/contingents are expected to arrive at the campsite **within the afternoon of Thursday, March 21 until the morning of Friday, March 22 not later than 7:00 AM** complete with packed meals, and all the things needed for the camping.

The Opening Ceremony on March 22 will start at 8:30 in the morning to be followed by the Parade.

Compensatory Time Off/Service Credit

Compensatory Time Off (CTO) or Service Credit can be claimed for the extra service rendered on Saturday and Sunday.

Enclosed are the Application Form, and Health Examination Form which must be filled-out and submitted upon pre-registration on March 16, 2019 at the Bohol Girl Scout Council in Tamblot Street, Tagbilaran City, Bohol.


