SUBJECT : COUNCIL ROLL-OUT TRAINING ON GIRL POWERED NUTRITION (GPN) PROGRAM FOR TROOP LEADERS

DATE : FEBRUARY 28, 2019

The World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS) has partnered with the Girl Scouts of the Philippines, and Nutrition International (NI) of Canada to deliver a Global Nutrition Program in the Philippines dubbed as Girl Powered Nutrition Program (GPN) which aims to improve knowledge and awareness of nutritional needs, and dietary practices among girls and their communities through a nutrition curriculum and other program components.

National, and Regional Roll-Out Training events on this program were held at the GSP National Headquarters in Manila, and GSP Visayas Region in Cebu City, respectively. Roll-Out Training in the Councils are now scheduled for all thirteen councils in the Visayas Region to be able for all leaders to be ready to deliver the GPN badge to girls.

Bohol Girl Scout Council's **Roll-Out Training on Girl Powered Nutrition (GPN) Program for Troop Leaders** is set on **March 15-17, 2019** at the **Bohol Public School Teachers and Employees Association (BPSTEA)** in **Tamblot Circumferencial Road, Tagbilaran City, Bohol.**

Hereunder are the pertinent details of the roll-out training:

Participants

- Registered Star, Junior, or Senior Troop Leaders

Registration Fee & Inclusions

One Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P1,800.00) per participant to cover for meals & snacks, training kit/materials, and other training expenses.

The registration fee, and transportation/travelling expenses of the participants are chargeable against Division/School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), District share of SMFC tickets, local and other sources of funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Arrival and Departure

- Participants are expected to be at the venue on March 15 (Friday) not later than 7:30 in the morning in their GSP Business Uniform. Opening Ceremony will start at 8:00 AM.
- Participants will leave after the Closing Ceremony on the afternoon of March 17 (Sunday).
- The training is a live-in training, thus, all participants should stay and sleep at the venue for the whole duration.

Meals

First Meal is Breakfast on March 15 (Friday) from 7:00-8:00 AM, and last meal is P.M. Snacks on March 17 (Sunday).


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
