**CONDUCT OF THE 1<sup>ST</sup> PHILHEALTH QUIZ BEE**

To: SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS

1. The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) Regional Office VII rolled out the PhilHealth Learners' Material (PLM) in Central Visayas beginning 2017. Music, Arts, Physical Education, and Health (MAPEH) Teachers, Coordinators, and Education Program Supervisors were trained on how to use the PLM in teaching Grade 10 Students the basic principles, vision, mission behind national Health Insurance Program (NHIP), and the concept of social health insurance as financing mechanism. This year, PhilHealth will be celebrating its 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary on February 14, 2019. One of the highlights of its celebration is the conduct of the **1<sup>st</sup> PhilHealth National Quiz Bee**, a competition for Grade 10 to 12 students nationwide.

2. The competition will be held in four (4) levels; 1) Division Level; 2) Regional and NCR Branch Level; 3) Area and PRO NCR Level; and 4) the National Level (Final Competition). This quiz will test the learner's knowledge on PhilHealth benefits, services, policies, and spelling ability on health-related terms.

3. Schools Division Superintendents of the 19 Divisions are advised to conduct the Division Level Competition for the month of October to have a contestant for the Regional Level that will happen on **November**. The competition shall only be for the PUBLIC school learners.

4. The winner and the winning coach in the Division Level shall receive a Prize from the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth).

5. Quiz materials shall be provided by PhilHealth Offices, Chief Social Insurance Officers on the day of the Division scheduled competition.

6. To ensure smooth conduct of the competition, the Division assigned focal person for this activity is requested to coordinate with the designated Chief Social Insurance Officer. (see attached communication)

7. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance of this Memorandum is desired.



## General Guidelines in the Conduct of First PhilHealth National Quiz Bee

### I. OBJECTIVES

The conduct of First PhilHealth National Quiz Bee, aims to achieve the following objectives:

- a. Test the knowledge of the students on PhilHealth's products and services.
- b. Test the spelling ability of the students on health-related terms.
- c. Enhance and deepen the knowledge of the students about PhilHealth.
- d. Serve as a venue in the improvement of PhilHealth Learner's Material (PLM) which has been rolled-out in the School Year 2017-2018.
- e. Encourage students to become advocates of PhilHealth.
- f. Encourage/boost the adoption of the PLM by private secondary schools.

### II. FUNCTIONS OF THE CONCERNED OFFICES

#### 1. Department of Education (DepEd)

- a. Shall assist in disseminating awareness and information on the details of the competition to all concerned public and private schools nationwide.
- b. Shall enjoin the schools to participate in the competition.
- c. Shall facilitate the mechanics of the competition or selection at the Division Level including the preparation of questions for the competition.
- d. Shall certify that the contestants have no relative who is/are a DepEd employee up to the fourth degree of consanguinity or affinity
- e. Shall coordinate with the concerned PhilHealth Regional Office counterpart during preparation and conduct of the competition.
- f. Shall coordinate with the PhilHealth Head Office for preparations for the conduct of the National Level of the competition.

#### 2. Corporate Marketing Department (CorMar), PhilHealth

- a. Shall be the lead office for the conduct of the First PhilHealth National Quiz Bee with assistance and support from the Social Health Insurance Academy (SHIA).
- b. Shall coordinate with the DepEd Head Office, through SHIA, for the guidance in the conduct of the competition
- c. Shall prepare the mechanics of the competition from Regional and PRO NCR Branch Level up to the National Level.
- d. Shall bring the questionnaire to the venue on the day of the competition, for purposes of security and confidentiality.
- e. Shall facilitate the procurement of medals, plaque, and giveaways for the contestants and guests.
- f. Shall manage the execution of the National Level competition set in February 2020.

#### 3. Social Health Insurance Academy (SHIA), PhilHealth

- a. Shall prepare the questionnaires for Levels II, III, and IV including backup/tiebreaker questions and answers.
- b. Shall assist the CorMar in coordinating with DepEd for the conduct of the competition.

- c. Shall extend the necessary assistance to CorMar in preparing for the conduct of the competition.

**4. PhilHealth Regional Offices (PROs) and PRO NCR Branches**

- a. Shall coordinate with the DepEd office in their respective regions for preparations in the conduct of the competition.
- b. Shall verify the qualifications of the contestants according to the qualifying conditions set for this competition.
- c. Shall manage the execution of the Regional and PRO NCR Branch Level competition including but not limited to confirmation of participants, venue, set-up of venue, meals, travelling and accommodation of contestants, etc.

**5. Office of the Area Vice President and PRO NCR, PhilHealth**

- a. Shall coordinate with the DepEd office in their respective areas for preparations in the conduct of the competition.
- b. Shall manage the execution of the Area and PRO NCR Level competition including but not limited to confirmation of participants, venue, set-up of venue, meals, travelling and accommodation of contestants, etc.

**III. BUDGETARY PROVISIONS**

Prizes for Level I competition shall be charged to PhilHealth and all necessary expenses for the conduct of Levels II, III, and IV. Transportation and accommodation expenses of the qualified contestants including their coach and one of his/her family member during Levels III and IV of the competition shall be budgeted by PhilHealth.

## V. COMPETITION MECHANICS AND PRIZES

### A. General Mechanics

1. The competition shall be open to all presently enrolled Grades 10, 11, and 12 Students in public and private schools recognized by DepEd nationwide.
2. Relatives of PhilHealth and DepEd employees up to the fourth degree of consanguinity or affinity are NOT QUALIFIED TO JOIN the contest.

3. All contestants shall accomplish the Registration Form (Annex A) and submit to the nearest PhilHealth Office at least five working days before the day of Division Level competition.
4. Contestants are allowed to have one (1) coach, who must be a MAPEH faculty member of the school that the contestant represents.
5. During the contest, the coach shall be assigned a specific area in the competition venue where he/she can observe the contestant.
6. The PhilHealth National Quiz Bee will be in four levels:
  - a. **Level I – Division Level.** In this level, the DepEd Division Offices shall conduct the elimination or selection of the contestants who will join the Regional and PRO NCR Branch Level. Each Division shall have only one (1) contestant in the Level II competition.
  - b. **Level II - Regional and PRO NCR Branch Level.** Contestants are the champions from the Division Levels.
  - c. **Level III - Area and PRO NCR Level.** Contestants are the champions in the Regional and PRO NCR Branch Levels.
  - d. **Level IV - National Level.** Contestants are the champions in the Area and PRO NCR Level. At this point, there shall be five final contestants (one representative per Area and in PRO NCR).
7. An Official Timekeeper shall be assigned by PhilHealth on the day of Levels II, III, and IV of the competition. He/She shall be responsible in monitoring the time allotted for each question.
8. Failure of the qualified contestant/s to appear on the day and time set for the conduct of the competition in each level shall be automatically disqualify him/her from joining the competition. Replacement of contestant/s shall NOT BE ALLOWED in all levels.
9. The questions will cover the PhilHealth Corporate Profile, policies on benefits, products and services, other matters concerning PhilHealth and UHC Act 11223, and health matters in general.
10. Specific rules on the actual conduct of the Quiz Bee shall be discussed at the beginning of the competition.
11. The official judges shall determine the correctness of the answers given by the contestants. They will also oversee and settle any disputes or complaints that may occur during the competition.
12. The conduct of Level I competition will be in September to October 2019. Level II competition will be in November 2019 during one of the PROs and Branches' Corporate events such as PhilHealth Forward, Employers Forum, etc. Level III of the competition shall be within November to December 2019 which shall similarly take place during any corporate event being conducted by the PRO/Area. Level IV competition will be held in February 2020 as one of the activities during PhilHealth's 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration within Metro Manila.
13. At the end of each competition level, the Champion and Runner-ups shall be formally recognized but only the Champion advances to the next round.
14. Contestants will be automatically disqualified to join or continue the competition for any violation committed or non-compliance to competition rules.
