HEALTH EVENT AND INCIDENT REPORTING SYSTEM

- TO: Public Schools/Acting Public Schools District Supervisors
 School Administrators/School-in-Charge
 School Health and Nutrition Personnel
 Teaching and Non-teaching Personnel
 All Others Concerned
 - Supplementary to all existing channels of reporting shall be an online reporting system
 that will be the means for DepEd teaching and non-teaching personnel to report Health-related
 events and incidents that occur during the current CoVID situation and thereafter.
 - 2. Events and incidents that are reportable during the current situation and thereafter are the following:
 - A. Incidents involving DepEd Learners and Staff such as, but not limited to:
 - Identified Teenage Pregnancy/ Teenage Parenthood
 - Drug-related incidents
 - iii. Dengue Cases
 - iv. Measles Cases
 - v. Rabies Cases
 - vi. Mental Health-related incidents
 - vii. Aiieged Spirit Possession "sanip"
 - viii. Suicide Attempt/Incident
 - ix. Food Poisoning
 - Vehicular Accidents
 - xi. And other similar incidents that adversely affect learners and staff of the Division of Bohol
 - B. **Health-related Activities** any health-related activity/program conducted by the school/district (when normal school operations resume)





3. All concerned are enjoined to report the said incidents/events within one (1) week from occurrence or as soon as practically possible to the following link:
