OBSERVANCE OF SAFETY MEASURES TO ADDRESS PREVAILING COVID-19 THREATS

To: Public Schools District Supervisors / Acting Public Schools District Supervisors School Administrators / School-In-Charge Teaching and Non-teaching personnel All others concerned

- In view of Executive Order No. 28 issued by the Bohol Provincial Government, "Placing The Province Of Bohol Under General Community Quarantine To Address The Continued Threats Of COVID-19" and the establishment of "new normal" practices beyond the quarantine period, this office hereby recommends the following safety measures to be implemented in the entire Division of Bohol.
 - Wearing of face mask at all times.
 - Washing/sanitizing of hands and soaking in foot baths at a designated area before entry.
 - c. Temperature scanning at the entrance gate.
 - Strict observance of social distancing (2 meters from one another).
 - e. Observance of Department of Health (DOH) guidelines for area sanitation.
- Sustainable implementation of DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016 titled "Policy and Guidelines for the Comprehensive Water Sanitation and Hygiene in Schools (WinS) Program."

- All schools shall procure the necessary items for sanitation and disinfection, including the implementation of Wash In Schools (WINS) program with the utilization of MOOE Funds:
 - a. Infrared thermometer
 - b. Sanitizing and disinfecting agents
 - c. Face masks for teaching and non-teaching personnel
 - d. Hand washing and sanitation facilities
