SUBJECT

BASIC TRAINING COURSE FOR TROOP LEADERS

UNDER THE NEW NORMAL

- The Bohol Council, Boy Scouts of the Γhilippines is announcing the conduct of the Basic Training Course for Troop Leaders under the new normal on August 20 - 22, 2020.
- 2. Once again, this will be a blended face to face- online training with the use of various online Information Communication Technology (ICT) tools and equipment accessible to both trainers and learners. The training is designed as 1) A live-out training that will start at 8:00 AM until 5:00 PM for three (3) days; 2) A group of 9 shall converge at the selected venues complying to the minimum health standards like wearing of face masks, sanitizing with alcohol, observing social distancing and the use of thermal scanners.
- 3. Transportation, food and other related expenses including the registration fee of Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (P 750.00) per participant for the cost of training materials and administrative expenses can be charged to MOOE or any other available local school funds subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- Farticipants are required to secure medical certificate certifying no symptoms of any illness which will be submitted together with the registration fee prior to the training.

- All participants will be entitled to service credits/Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) in accordance with the existing policies and guidelines.
- 8. All participants must be in scout uniform or at least have an adult neckerchief and report to the training venue at 8:00 o'clock in the morning on the first day of the course.
