It seeks to acknowledge volunteers for their invaluable support and contribution to the PRC through the Red Cross Youth Services.

2020 SEARCH FOR THE BOHOL TEN OUTSTANDING RED CROSS YOUTH

I. Minimum Qualification and Requirements

- a. A resident of the Province of Bohol for at least four (4) years;
- b. Must be 16-25 years old on the date of the submission of the nomination package;
- c. An active Red Cross Youth volunteer who have excelled and contributed to the organization for at least four (2) years and must be enrolled in the Membership Accident Assurance Benefit Program;
- d. Must exemplify outstanding participation and involvement as an RCY volunteer in academics, co – curricular and extra-curricular;
- e. Must have no failing grades as reflected in academic documents;
- f. Must have spearheaded and implemented at least one (1) project under the Red Cross Youth (completed or ongoing);
- g. Must strictly come from an accredited and active Red Cross Youth School/ Community Council (school-based), a member of the Chapter Youth Council or an RCY Instructor;
- h. Must have completed the Leadership Development Program (LDP)
- i. Has not been subjected to any disciplinary case in campus nor has been charged and/or convicted in a civil or criminal case.

II. Requirements for Nominees

- a. All documents for submission must be in short sized bond paper;
- b. Two (2) copies of duly accomplished nomination forms inclusive of all documents in sequential order:
 - Duly Accomplished Nomination Form
 - Nominee's Personal Data Form
 - Two (2) Letters of Recommendation
 - from the school/employer (RCY Adviser or Principal/Immediate Supervisor or Employer)
 - from any person (not within the third degree of consanguinity and affinity) with deep knowledge about the nominee and his works as an RCY Volunteer and to other affiliations
 - Scanned copy of YVOC, LFC, BLT Certificates
 - Scanned copy of MAAB ID



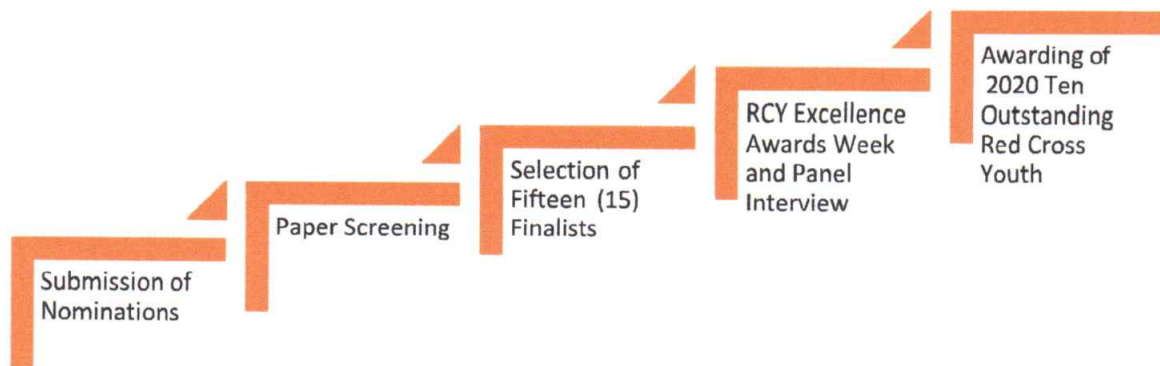
- Certificate of Good Moral Character (for students) or NBI Clearance (for graduates)
- Photocopy of Authenticated Birth Certificate (PSA Birth Certificate)
- Transcript of Records or Form 137 (certified true copy by the school)
- Project Background and Impact (implemented project)
- Nominee's Three (3) Most Significant Accomplishments
- Essays
- Nominee's Achievement Profile (from 2015 only)
 - Red Cross Youth Achievement Profile
 - Non – Red Cross Youth Achievement Profile
 - Academic Achievement Profile
- Supporting Documents (may include certificates, action photos, newspaper articles, etc.)
 - Red Cross Youth Achievements
 - Non – Red Cross Youth Achievements
 - Academic Achievements

III. The Search Process

- a. Submission of nominations shall be open to all qualified individuals. However, councils are encouraged to send at least one (1) RCY to the search.
- b. Bid books shall be received by the Red Cross Youth Excellence Awards Secretariat on or before the set date.
- c. The RCY Excellence Awards Secretariat shall intensively review all documents and attachments sent. Should there be any missing, unverified, or incomplete document or attachment, the nomination package shall be considered null and void and will not be subjected for further screening.
- d. The RCY Excellence Awards Screening committee shall identify fifteen (15) finalists for the 2020 Bohol Ten Outstanding Red Cross Youth. The finalists shall be informed through a formal correspondence to the nominee's school/ community council
- e. The fifteen (15) finalists shall be subjected for a panel interview by distinguished individuals.
- f. After all the finalists have been interviewed, the secretariat shall tabulate their final scores and the panel of interviewers shall deliberate as to who shall be named as the 2020 Bohol Ten Outstanding Red Cross Youth. Awardees shall not be ranked.

IV. **Disqualifications**

- a. *Immediate past, incumbent Chapter Youth Council Officers.*
- b. *Members of the RCY Excellence Awards Secretariat and Working Committee are automatically disqualified.*
- c. *Nominees and Finalists who have been found to tamper their submitted application will be automatically disqualified for the Bohol TORCY 2020.*
- d. *Any form of bribery among the applicants towards the RCY Excellence Awards Working Committee and Chapter Staff is strictly prohibited and will be subjected for disqualification.*
- e. *Grave misconduct of the shortlisted candidates in the duration of the screening and their service as ambassadors will be subjected for disqualification case.*
