Psychological First Aid (PFA) is a humane, supportive and practical assistance to fellow human beings who recently suffered a serious stressor. PFA is non-intrusive, practical care and support, assessing needs and concerns, helping people to address basic needs, listening, but not pressuring people to talk, comforting people and helping them to feel calm, helping people connect to information, services and social supports, and protecting people from further harm.
7. Department of Education (DepEd) has the capacity to provide PFA to learners, teachers, and school administrators at risk, through songs, dances, and other wellness activities.
