- Culture & Values Of Bol-Anon Family Illustration Contest (Secondary Category)

2. This activity aims to showcase artistic expressions of our learners both in elementary and secondary.

3. Expenses incurred by the school relative to its participation in the activity are chargeable against school mooe/local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures.

Theme: **“ALAB SINING, ALAY SIGLA”**

Activity Title: **“HIYAS” Handang Ibahagi ang Yaman Alay sa Sining**

**General Guidelines:**

1. The competition is open to all public secondary and elementary schools.
2. Categories for the competition are the following:
  - “Balak” (Spoken Word Poetry-Visayan Dialect) Elem. & Secondary Category
  - Digital Poster Making Contest (Secondary Category)
  - Culture & Values Of Bol-Anon Family Illustration Contest (Secondary Category)
  - Dance-sport Contest (Elem. & Secondary Category)
3. All participating individual/group shall secure and submit parents’ consent and waiver to the school principal. The school official shall ensure that this is complied.
4. Expenses incurred in the participation/conduct of this activity is chargeable to School MOOE.
5. To encourage wide participation, no participant may appear more than once in the competition. Participants in every category shall not be the same individuals.
6. A time limit of not more than 5 minutes is given for the performance of the “balak” and 90 seconds for the dance-sport. Corresponding one point from each judge’s total score shall be deducted in the event the time limit is exceeded.
7. For dances, performance of dangerous choreography/routine are strictly not allowed.
8. School entries are to be submitted to the office of the PSDS not later than February 18, 2021. All entries must be video-recorded of high-quality and must be properly labeled. District elimination will happen on the following day of February 19, 2021.
9. The PSDS shall chair the screening committee. Winning piece shall be officially endorsed by the PSDS to the Division Office not later than February 22, 2021 for the division finals which will be held on February 24, 2021. Only the division winner will receive a prize money and certificate of recognition.
10. The competition shall be judged by a jury of three members per category and the decision of the jury shall be final. The jury may require for an online introductory meeting with all division finalists through Google Meet. The link for joining the meeting will be announced later.
11. Everybody especially those involved in the conduct/participation, shall strictly observe and adhere to the health and safety protocols required of each one at these time of the COVID-19 pandemic.

**“BALAK” – Spoken Word Poetry Mechanics:**

1. Eligible to join the contest are 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders for elementary and any year level for the secondary.
2. Participants should be officially endorsed by the School head and only one participant per school.
3. Names should be submitted to the office of the Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS) together with the recorded video of the performance thru a google drive link, accessible by the PSDS.
4. Contestants are encouraged to draw inspiration from the theme **“Padayon Batang Bol-anon”** resiliency during times of pandemic.
5. The entry must be an original composition written and spoken in visayan dialect and recited in not more than 5 minutes. Use of idiomatic words or phrases is allowed provided that it is relevant to the theme. Entries with malicious or offensive content, however, will be automatically disqualified.

6. The following are the criteria for judging:

Organization (clarity of thought, structure, coherence)	-	25%
Delivery and Style (unique storytelling, performance )	-	25%
Language (suitable descriptive language, word play )	-	15%
Content (depth of concept, relevance of theme)	-	35%

## DIGITAL POSTER MAKING CONTEST MECHANICS:

1. Eligible to join the contest are the Junior High School and Senior High School students in public secondary schools of Bohol Division.
2. Participants should be officially endorsed by the School head and only one participant per school.
3. Names should be submitted to the office of the Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS) together with the recorded video of the performance and the save file of the worked poster thru a google drive link, accessible by the PSDS.
4. The poster must depict or interpret the theme **“Padayon Batang Bol-anon”** and should have the theme and slogan written on the top front page of the poster.
5. Poster size is 8.5x11 inches (300 dpi), landscape layout. In layer & TIFF, JPG, PSD file format.
6. All artwork on the poster must be an original design. Those containing clip art and downloaded brushes will not be considered.
7. Appearance of participant’s name, organization’s name or logo, or any product/ brand name as a material or content in the poster is not allowed.
8. The poster should have not been submitted in previous contests or used or displayed in public.
9. The contestants will be using Editing Software’s like Photoshop, Paint, CorelDraw, Adobe etc.
10. The poster will be judged according to the following criteria:

Aesthetic appeal	-	30%
Technique and Workmanship	-	25%
Originality	-	25%
Relevance to the theme	-	<u>20%</u>

## CULTURE & VALUES OF BOL-ANON FAMILY ILLUSTRATION CONTEST MECHANICS:

1. Eligible to join the contest are the Junior High School and Senior High School students in public secondary schools of Bohol Division.
2. Participants should be officially endorsed by the School head and only one group-participant per school.
3. The team must be composed of two student illustrators.
4. Names should be submitted to the office of the Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS) together with the recorded video of the performance and the saved file of the worked illustration thru a google drive link, accessible by the PSDS.
5. The theme must depict the Culture and Values of Bol-anons, which one entry will be composed of the following set of illustrations:
  - A. Typical Bol-anon Family (individually illustrated: father figure, mother figure, ate, kuya, and bunso)
  - B. One (1) any Bol-anon Celebration
  - C. One (1) any Bol-anon Tradition
6. The canvass size is 8.5x11 inches (300 dpi), landscaped layout, and should be saved into two art formats : (1) Line Drawing (2) Color rendered.
  - a. Line arts or line drawings should use lines of BLACK color with thickness of at least 0.7mm.
  - b. Color rendered drawings. The student-illustrator are free to choose his/her rendering technique provided that these are not downloaded hatch/es or mask.
  - c. All illustrations should be saved individually as Portable Network Graphics (png) file format with transparent background.
7. All illustrations must be the participants' original design. Those containing clip art and other downloaded elements will not be considered. The illustrations should have not been submitted in previous contests or used or displayed in public.
8. Appearance of participant's name, organization's name or logo, or any product/ brand name as a material or content in the illustrations is not allowed.
9. The contestants will use Graphics Editing Software/s like Photoshop, Paint, CorelDraw, Adobe etc.
10. The illustration will be judged according to the following criteria:

Aesthetic appeal	-	35%
Creativity and Originality	-	35%
Relevance	-	30%

## LATIN DANCE-SPORTS COMPETITION (ELEMENTARY)

### Mechanics:

1. This contest is open preferably to grade 5 and grade 6 learners in public elementary schools in the Division of Bohol.
2. Participants should be officially endorsed by the School head and only one couple participant per school.
3. Names should be submitted to the office of the Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS) together with the recorded video of the dance performance google drive link, accessible by the PSDS.
4. The entry must be a pair of a male and a female learners who will dance the following dances:
  - >Chachacha
  - >Samba
  - >Jive
5. The entry must be a recorded video of the couple dancing the 3 dances with 90 seconds as the maximum time per dance and a short introduction of names of the couple and the represented school before the start of the first dance.
6. The couple has the privilege to choose their music.
7. The couple must wear dance-sport costumes, but safety and modesty must be the priority. Strictly no daring and too much exposure of the body of each dancer.
8. Strictly no lifting as the highlight of the routines to avoid accidents.
9. The entries will be judged according to the following criteria:

>Timing	-	25%
>Choreography and style	-	25%
>Posture and Poise	-	10%
>Floor Craft	-	20%
>Interpretation of the Dance	-	<u>20%</u>
Total	-	100%

3. Names should be submitted to the office of the Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS) together with the recorded video of the dance performance google drive link, accessible by the PSDS.
4. The entry must be a pair of a male and a female learners who will dance the following dances:
  - >Chachacha
  - >Samba
  - >Rumba
5. The entry must be a recorded video of the couple dancing the 3 dances with 90 seconds as the maximum time per dance and a short introduction of names of the couple and the represented school before the start of the first dance.
6. The couple has the privilege to choose their music.
7. The couple must wear dance-sport costumes, but safety and modesty must be the priority. Strictly no daring and too much exposure of the body of each dancer.
8. Strictly no lifting as the highlight of the routines to avoid accidents.
9. The entries will be judged according to the following criteria:
