GENERAL GUIDELINES (Updated as of February 23, 2021)

- 1. Open to all Girls in all levels who have registered with their troops for the current year.
- 2. Contestants must have been declared the best performer in one particular category during the school/district/area level competition (through virtual/online or recorded video or combination of both). Contestants who are hand-picked without the benefit of participating in a contest are disqualified to join in any level of the Girl Scouts Got Talent.
- Contestants shall vie under one category only in any level of the contest.
- 4. First prize winners of the previous Provincial Girl Scouts Got Talent are disqualified to vie In the same category/level where they had won.
- 5. Contestants shall wear the Girl Scout Dress Uniform with scarf and pins.
- 6. The Provincial Level Contest shall be held virtually via Zoom but there will be no more live performance. The eight Areas shall submit to the Council all the video entries of their contestants. All submitted videos shall be shown during the contest proper to be attended by the Contestants, and Judges.
- 7. The video entries must have very clear audio and video with good quality and resolution.
- 8. The District Field Advisers (DFA) of the host districts during the Area Level competition shall submit to the Council a USB containing the following:
 - 8.1 Accomplished Area Level Results Form
 - 8.2 Videos entries of the 11 contestants performing their respective contest categories
 - 8.3 Copy of the Twinkler Poem in Word file
 - 8.4 Copy of the lyrics of the song (Song Writing Senior) in Word file
 - 8.5 Copy of the Spoken Poetry (Cadet) in Word file
- The USB shall be submitted to the Council 3 days after the Area Level competition, or on or before February 28, 2021.

- 10.Link of the Zoom Event shall be given to the contestants/persons concerned (only to the Email Address or FB Name provided in the Area Level Results Form) 2 days prior to the provincial event.
- 11. Contestants shall use the format Area + First Name + Surname as the Zoom display name. Example: A1 Josefa Escoda or A5 Olave Powell or A8 Gespie Bohol
- 12. Contestants shall be online at least 30 minutes before the scheduled contest time of their categories and wait to be accepted by the Host/Council,
- 13. Camera/Video of contestants must be turned on all throughout the contest.
- 14. Contestants shall abide by the above-mentioned rules and guidelines.
- 15. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.
