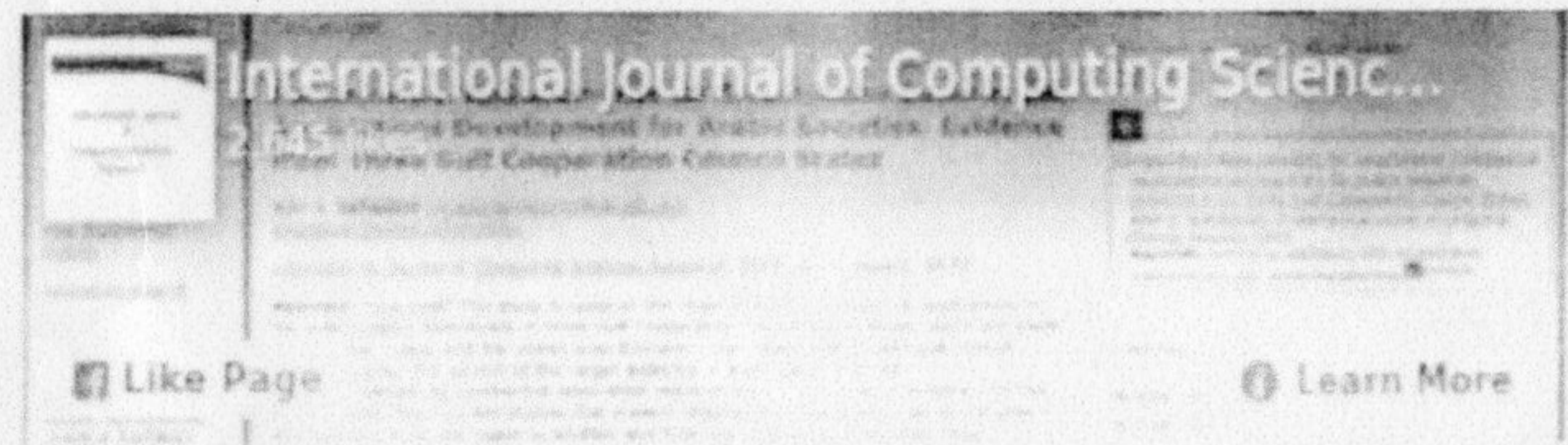

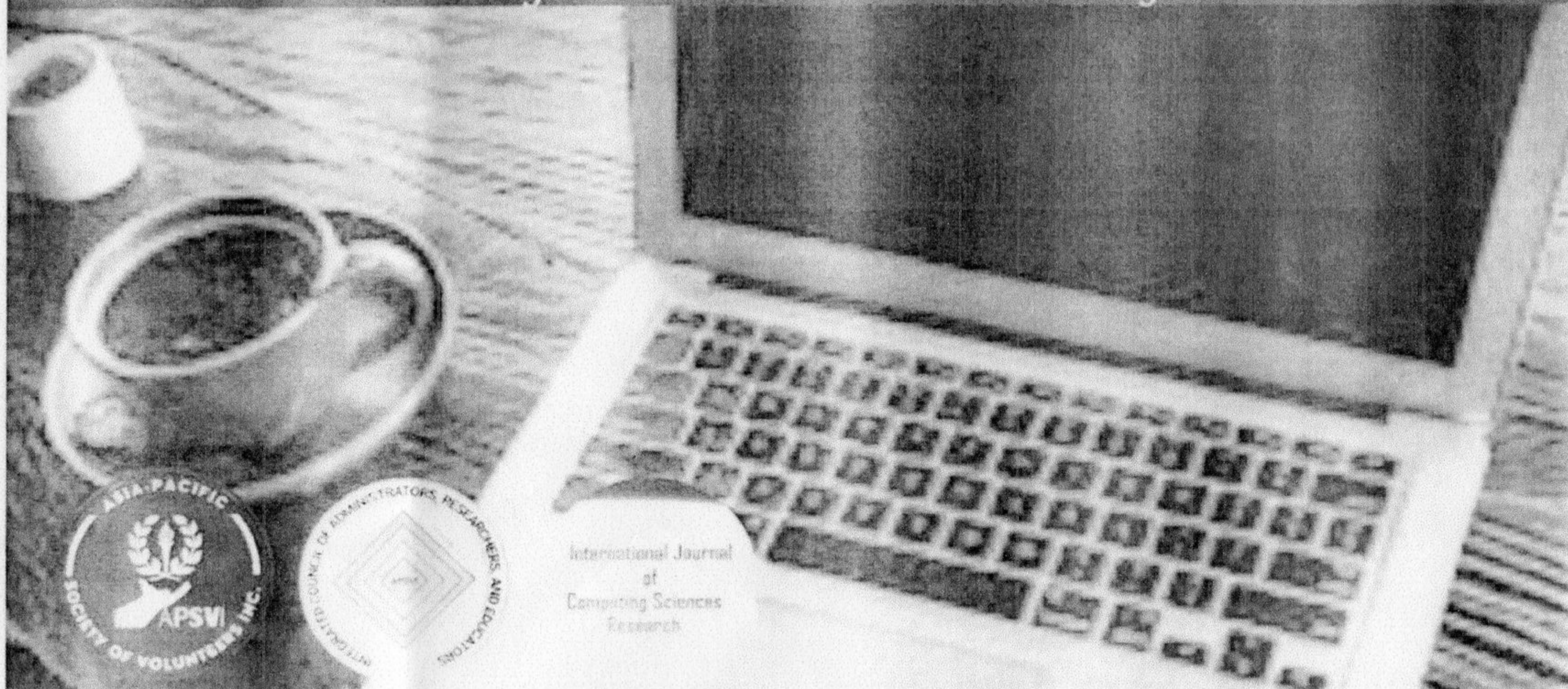



2. All interested administrators, researchers and educators are eligible to submit their abstracts.
3. Abstracts must be submitted online: **apsvi.conference@gmail.com**
4. All papers shall undergo double-blind review.
5. Participant whose abstract has been accepted must submit his/her paper in full.
6. Full papers should follow the IMRD (Introduction, Method, Results and Discussion) format with a minimum of 4,000 and a maximum of 6,000 words.
7. It should be typed in Word document with the following mechanics: Title (with researcher's name, affiliation, academic institution, and e-mail address); Abstract (150 to 250 words); Keywords (up to 5 words only, alphabetical); Font style and size - Arial; 12; Spacing - 1.15; Margin - 1.5 (left) x 1 (right) x 1 (top) x 1 (bottom); and Paper size - 8.5 x 11.

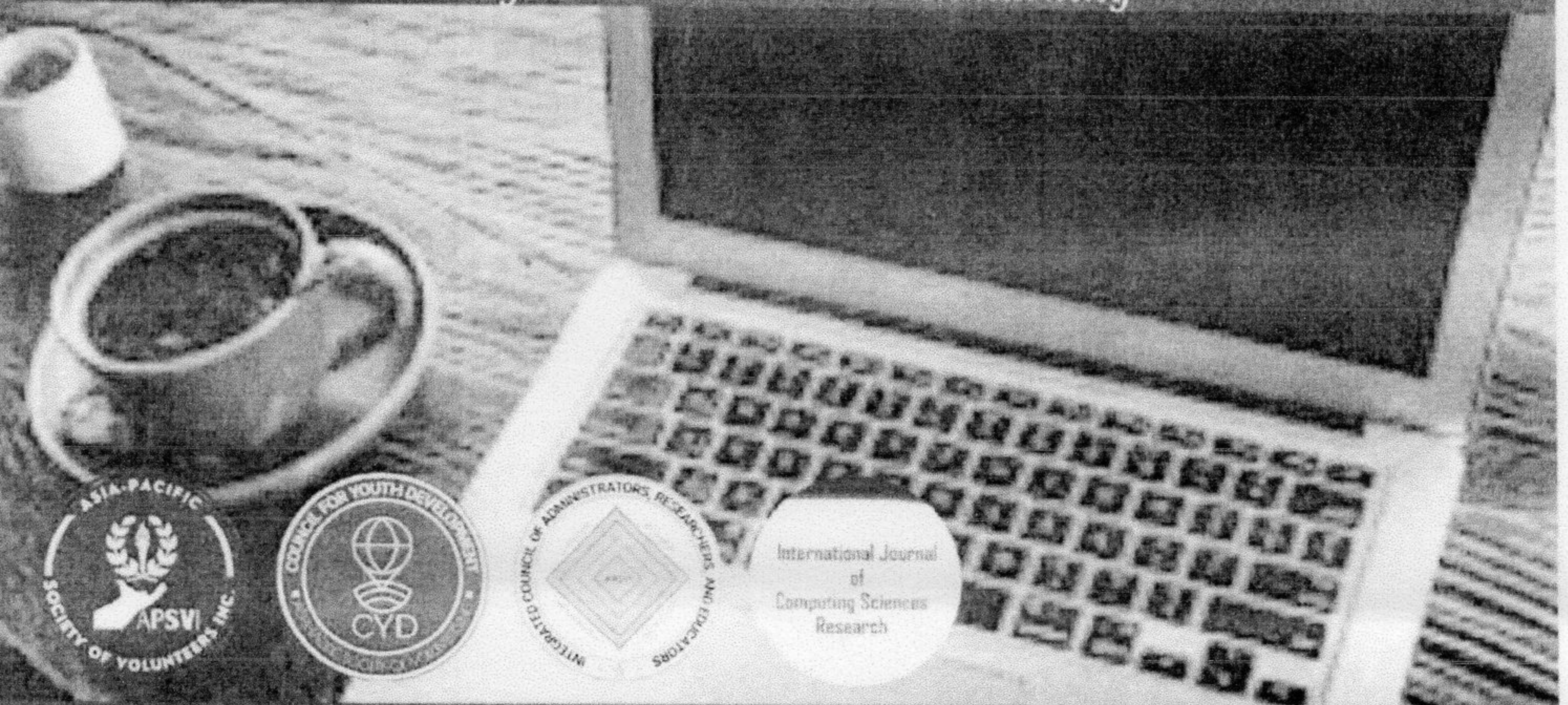

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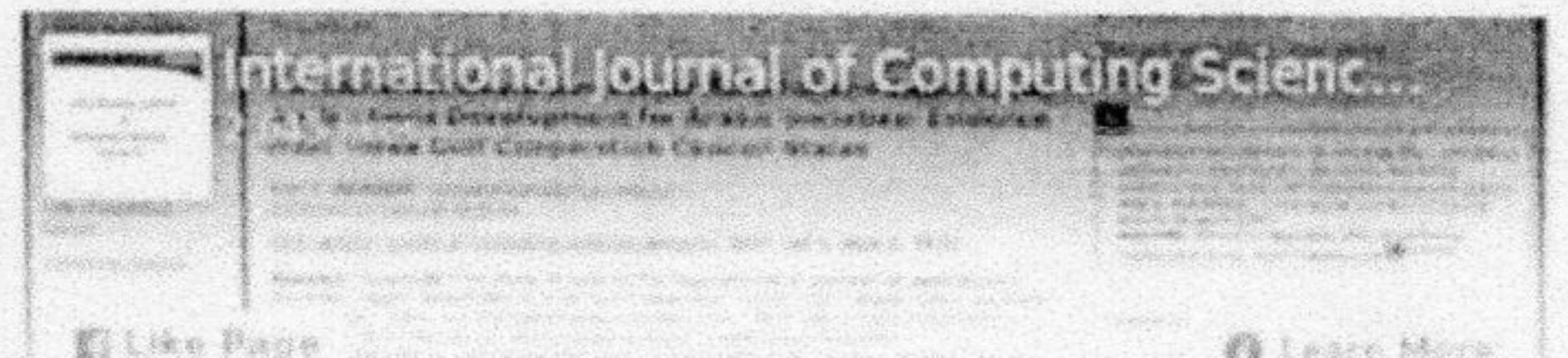
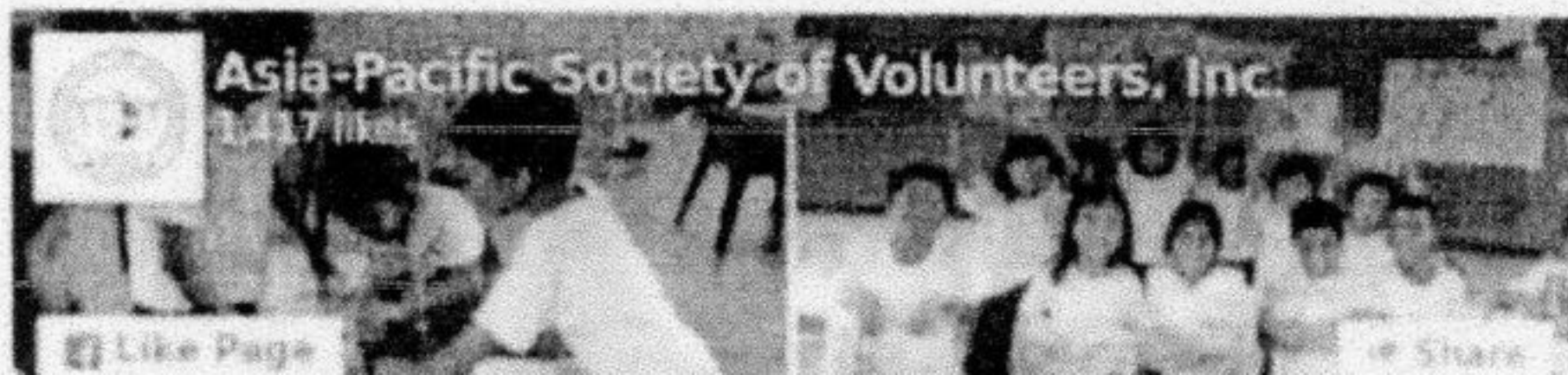
