DIVISION VALIDATION OF THE SBM LEVEL OF PRACTICE OF SCHOOLS

1. This Office announces the conduct of the on-site **Division Validation of the SBM Level of Practice of Schools** at the District Level on October 4 to 8 and October 11 to 15, 2021. District schedules per Congressional District shall be posted in the PSDSs' group chats by the CD SBM Task Force Team Leader.
2. The activity aims to capture notable SBM practices; verify the authenticity of the results of the school's self-assessment of its SBM Level of Practice; and identify areas for possible provision of technical assistance.
3. As previously announced, the validation shall be conducted in the Central School or in any big school in the District. Only the top five (5) Elementary Schools in terms of SBM Level of Practice and all Secondary Schools of the District shall be validated.
4. Each school to be validated shall occupy one big classroom to display its SBM Portfolios of MOVs. Tables and chairs should be available inside each display area for the Division SBM Task Force's use. The School Head and the School SBM Coordinator shall be on hand as "taong-bahay" in case the validators have queries.
5. The Division SBM Task Force for every Congressional District is composed of more or less fourteen (14) persons, to include the Division Field Technical Assistance Team (DFTAT), assigned to look into the different dimensions of SBM.
6. Simplicity and austerity shall be observed in the preparation of the conduct of the activity.
7. Expenses relative to the conduct of the Division Validation of the SBM Level of Practice of Schools shall be charged to Division/School MOOE, as the case may be.
8. All participants to this activity are expected to have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Health and safety protocols shall be observed at all times during the conduct of the validation.
9. For the information and guidance of all concerned.
