COUNCIL CIRCULAR NO. 17 Series of 2021

SUBJECT : SEARCH FOR THE BEST INGENIOUS BAYONG EXTENDED

DATE : OCTOBER 25, 2021

In response to the field's request for extension considering that most of the troops/girls register/re-register within the months of September to November, we have extended the contest submission deadline of the **Search for the Best Ingenious Bayong** to Tuesday, November 30, 2021, (Refer to Council Circular Nos. 14 and 16, Series 2021 dated August 19 and 25, respectively).

Below is the updated Guidelines for the Search.

1. The contest is open to all registered Junior, Senior or Cadet Girl Scouts of Bohol Girl Scout Council who must create the bayong together with at least one (1) adult family member who should also be registered with the Girl Scouts.

Both male and female adult family members can register individually as Associate Members or with a group as Barangay Committee Members or District Committee Members. For female members, they can opt to register as Other Adult Volunteer - Career Woman.
2. The search will run from September 1 to November 30, 2021 thus all interested to join who are not yet registered Girl Scouts must register before joining the contest to qualify.
3. The materials to be used to create the bayong could be as follows
 - 3.1 Indigenous Materials - Naturally and locally found in a specific place such as timbers, canes, grass, palms, and rattan.
 - 3.2 Recyclable Materials - Plastic bottles, wrappers or anything as long as it can be recycled and readily available.
4. The bayong must be functional and must have the dimensions of 10.7 inches in height, 16 inches in width, 4.3 inches in depth, and 7.3 inches in the handle.

5. Five pictures of the finished bayong in high definition (HD) quality will be required for submission - front view, back view, side view, top view, and bottom view. Include also a formal picture of the contestants (Girl and adult family member/s) holding the bayong. Strictly no filters. The Girl must wear the GS Dress Uniform with scarf.
6. The six specified pictures (5 photos of the bayong and 1 family photo) along with a scanned copy of the contestants' Registration Forms, and the information below must be emailed at gspbohol@gmail.com **on or before November 30, 2021**. Format of the email subject must be BIB - Age Level, Name of Girl Contestant & District (E.g.: BIB – Cadet Maria dela Cruz, Jagna)

Document with the following information must be emailed in Word format:

- A. Girl
 - a. Complete Name
 - b. Age Level
 - c. Name of School and District
 - d. Date of Troop Registration
 - e. Contact Number
 - B. Adult Family Member/s
 - a. Complete Name
 - b. Relationship to the Girl
 - c. Date of GSP Registration
 - C. Bayong's Name and Brief Description
7. The Top Ten (10) Bayong will be chosen from the entries submitted which will be presented by the contestants to the judges virtually via Zoom on December 6, 2021. The Best Ingenious Bayong - 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be chosen from the top ten.
 8. The First, Second, and Third Place Winners will receive cash prizes worth Ten Thousand (P10,000), Five Thousand (P5,000), and Three Thousand (P3,000) respectively; and a Consolation Prize of One Thousand (P1,000.00) each for the other seven (7) finalists. Cash prizes will be sponsored by the Derikito-Oppus Family. Certificate of Recognition and badges under the Challenge of Heritage and Citizenship, Challenge of the Arts, and Challenge of Family Life will also be awarded by the Council. The awarding of winners will be held sometime in December, 2021. The exact date will be announced on the Council's FB Page – GSP Bohol Council.
9. Criteria for Judging

Concept	30%	Originality	20%
Creativity	30%	Resourcefulness	20%
 10. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.

11. The three (3) Best Ingenious Bayong will officially become the property of the Derikito-Oppus Family (contest sponsor) and must be submitted upon claiming the prize during the Awarding Day (TBA) at the Council Program and Training Center at 16 Tambiot Street, Cogon District, Tagbilaran City.

All the other contestants will be awarded Certificate of Participation, and badges under the Challenge of Heritage and Citizenship, Challenge of the Arts, and Challenge of Family Life.
