COACHES COURSE LEVEL I

DAUIS BOHOL

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. PARTICIPANTS

General conditions, participant must be:

- 18 55 years old
- physically fit
- able to speak one of the FIVB official language

2. EXAMINATIONS

Examinations are, in essence, a confirmation that the participants have understood the course materials and are able to apply the knowledge they have learned. The guidelines for the examination will be explained by the Course Director at the beginning of the course. The RVA Coaches Course Level I examinations are composed of three elements: PRACTICAL – WRITTEN – ORAL

PRACTICAL EXAMINATION FOR RVA COACHES COURSE LEVEL I

Candidate must demonstrate their practical coaching skills with the following four drills limited by time as follows:

COACHING SKILL	NUMBER OF ATTEMPTS	TIME LIMIT	POINTS
Service for Reception	20 attempts	2.5 minutes	20 points
Toss for Set	20 attempts	1.5 minutes	20 points
Toss for Spike	20 attempts	2.0 minutes	20 points
Spike for Defense	20 attempts	1.5 minutes	20 points

PRACTICAL EXAMINATION CONTENT:

SERVING FOR RECEPTION

- 20 services, free choice of style, free position behind service line
- 4 consecutive services in each of the marked sections of the court
- each served ball should touch the floor
- time limit is 2.5 minutes

TOSS FOR SETTING

- 20 freestyle tosses from position VI to the setting position
- 10 accurate tosses between zone II and III close to the net
- 10 bad tosses very close to and off the net, high and low, etc.
- 3 setters to penetrate one by one from zone I and to set to zone IV
- time limit is 1.5 minutes

TOSSING BALLS FOR SPIKING

- 20 tosses from setting position
- 10 tosses for quick spikes from position III
- 10 tosses for high ball spikes from position IV
- 3 spikers approach one by one to spike quick balls / high balls
- time limit is 2.0 minutes

SPIKING FOR DEFENSE

- 20 consecutive spikes from zone II to zone V
- 3 players one by one play in defense / digging
- time limit is 1.5 minutes

GRADING CRITERIA:

- Each correct service, toss and spike counts 1 point
- The following should be taken into consideration:
 - organization of the drills
 - running the drills well with rhythm
 - control on the proper techniques and corrections of players' actions
 - prevention of injuries during drills
- In case of a candidate's poor techniques, disorganized drills and corrections of players' action that were neglected, deductions shall be made from the number of points scored
- 45 POINTS is sufficient to PASS the PRACTICAL EXAMINATION

PRACTICAL EXAMINATION RESULT:

- Should participant fail the practical examination, but within the score range of 35 – 44, participant will be entitled for a retake of the practical examination
- Should participant fail the practical examination, within the score range of 0 – 34, participant will be considered as having failed the course

WRITTEN EXAMINATION FOR RVA COACHES COURSE LEVEL I

- The written component is comprised of 50 items
- The passing grade for the WRITTEN EXAMINATION is 30 points

ORAL EXAMINATION FOR RVA COACHES COURSE LEVEL I

 Should a participant scored 25 – 29 in the written examination, the Course Director is entitled to propose an oral examination to the participant so that he / she may have a second chance to pass the written examination

Match Management and Personality	25 points

60 POINTS is sufficient to PASS the PRACTICAL EXAMINATION

PRACTICAL EXAMINATION RESULT:

- Should participant fail the practical examination, but within the score range of 55 - 59, participant will be entitled for a retake of the practical examination
- Should participant fail the practical examination, within the score range of 0 – 54, participant will be considered as having failed the course

WRITTEN EXAMINATION FOR RVA REFEREEING COURSE

- The written component is comprised of 50 items
- The passing grade for the WRITTEN EXAMINATION is 30 points

ORAL EXAMINATION FOR RVA REFEREING COURSE
