

- Costume must be appropriate to the concept of the dance. Nudity is strictly prohibited.

- 7. Submitted final video recording must be shot on a one camera focus [no editing will be allowed] with at least two meters away from the service microphone.
- 8. Deadline of submission will be on the 29th day of October, 2021. Virtual competition will be on November 28, 2021 Sunday.

9. All National Finalists [Student-Participant, Teacher-Trainer/Coach and the School Represented] will be given a Certificate of Recognition/Commendation. Medals, Certificate of Ranking and a trophy for the Winning Top Three position [Champion, First Runner Up and Second Runner Up].
