LAUNCHING OF THE DEPED BOHOL NON-COMMUNICABLE DISEASES PROGRAM

- I. A study entitled "Cardiovascular Disease Risk Level of the Division Office Personnel of the Department of Education, Division of Bohol" was conducted during the fourth quarter of 2019.
- II. The said research involved the participation of 101 personnel of the schools division office and assessed their risk for the development of a fatal or near-fatal cardiovascular event within the next ten years using the PhilPEN (Philippine Package of Essential Non-communicable diseases) Protocol. Among the most notable findings of the study were the following:
 - a. High prevalence of Obesity among the SDO personnel;
 - b. The Prominence of sedentary lifestyles;
 - c. Family History of Hypertension and Diabetes
- III. The utilization of findings and recommendations of the aforesaid research are the following:
 - a. Provision of free laboratory package to SDO personnel for the annual medical examination (done last July to August 2021);
 - b. Establishment of a Workplace Wellness Program;
 - c. Creation of hypertensives and diabetics health clubs;
 - d. Procurement of exercise equipment and program related medicines and supplies





- IV. In this regard, the Schools Division of Bohol undertakes the ceremonial launching of the Non-Communicable Diseases Program at the Schools Division Office on November 29, 2021.
- V. The launching shall highlight the awareness on non-communicable diseases through a short program following the flag-raising ceremony and the provision of basic services to SDO personnel and participants throughout the launching day.
