3. In preparation for the said activity, a **List of Target Learners** and **Parent's Signed Consent** and clearance from local IATF regarding Face-to-Face application of Fluoride Varnish to Kinder to Grade 3 learners of the 4 pilot schools for face to face classes and 48 School Dental Health Care Program (SDHCP) District Beneficiary School Clinics are needed for the preparation of supplies and materials for the activity and to be submitted to your District School Dentist or send via email to [vina.aki@deped.gov.ph](mailto:vina.aki@deped.gov.ph) on or before November 24, 2021. If submission is via email, please indicate with or without consent next to the name of the learner. A hard copy of the list of learners and parent's signed consent shall be submitted to your Dentist for record purposes and safekeeping at the District SDHCP Clinic.

4. The following activities are to be conducted during the implementation process:
- a. Conduct of face to face **Dental Health Talks** by batch of 5 learners and maximum of 20 per day per class
  - b. Conduct of **Hand Washing Drill** by batch of 5 learners and maximum of 20 per day per class
  - c. Conduct of **Tooth Brushing Drill** by batch of 5 learners and maximum of 20 per day per class
  - d. Conduct of **Oral Examination** by batch of 5 learners and maximum of 20 per day per class
  - e. Conduct of **Fluoride Varnish Application** by batch of 5 learners and maximum of 20 per day per class
  - f. Conduct of **Extraction of unsavable tooth/ Oral Urgent Treatment (OUT)**
5. Fluoride Application will start on December 9, 2021 and will end on August 2022, the date of expiry of the Fluoride varnish. All Dentists and Dental Aides will report to these Face to Face Pilot Schools on the following dates:
- a. December 9, 2021- Cantiquib ES, Albuquerque District
  - b. December 13, 2021- Sto. Nino ES, Getafe District
  - c. December 14, 2021- Triple Union ES, Loboc District

d. December 15, 2021- Can-Oling ES, Dagohoy District

6. After the implementation of Fluoride application to the 4 face to face Pilot schools, all Dentists and Dental Aides are to report to their assigned districts to continue the implementation of Fluoride Varnish Application to K-G3 learners giving priority to the 48 SDHCP district beneficiary school clinics until August 2022.
7. In as much as we only have 6 Dentists currently serving the Division of Bohol with 48 SDHCP Beneficiary School Clinics, we are outsourcing partnership with the Philippine Dental Association - Bohol Chapter through the able leadership of our President, Dr. Amce Marie B. Pinos, to help us in the implementation to ensure utilization of the Fluoride varnish supplies before the said expiry date.
8. Please coordinate with your Division School Dentist as to the schedule of fluoride application in your respective districts and advise your K-G3 learners to bring their own health kits given to them for the said activity.
9. Narrative report with MOVs after the conduct of the activity shall be submitted via email to [vina.akip@deped.gov.ph](mailto:vina.akip@deped.gov.ph) and hard copy to the District School Dentist.
