1. During the mock and actual conduct of the 2021 ASEAN Quiz Division Level Competition on December 13, 2021 at 2:30 p.m. and December 14, 2021 at 1:00 p.m., respectively, the Public Schools District Supervisors or his/her trusted representative will act as proctor. Its purpose is to ensure that the integrity of the virtual ASEAN quiz is maintained. The district-designated proctor and coach must collaborate on the location and timing of the events.
2. All contestants who have qualified for the division level competition must register through this link: <https://tinyurl.com/BoholASEANRegistration>. Editable ASEAN Quiz registration form can be accessed in AP Bohol messenger group chat. Once you have registered online, you will be added in the "ASEAN Quiz 2021 Coaches" messenger group chat. This platform will be used to post future announcements and review materials.
3. Mr. Kieth Templa of Calape NHS is an additional member of the ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee. All committee members will report to BPSTEA Building, Tamblot St., Tagbilaran City in the afternoon of December 13, 2021 until December 14, 2021.
4. Attached is the ASEAN Quiz Division Level Competition revised mechanics.

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REVISED ASEAN QUIZ DIVISION LEVEL COMPETITION GUIDELINES RULES AND MECHANICS

1. The participants shall be seated separately in a working table.
2. Each participant shall have a computer/laptop with strong internet connectivity. The participants shall have access to Google meet and Classpoint provided by the quiz organizing committee for answering the segments of the quiz.
3. There will be two (2) segments to be used during the quiz: Segment 1: True or False and Multiple-Choice
Segment 2: Fill-in-the-Blanks or Completion.
4. Segment 1: The True or False part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given 1 point. The Multiple-Choice part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given 1 point. The total score is 20 points.
5. Segment 2: The Fill in the Blanks or Completion will have 15 questions. Each correct answer will be given 3 points. The total score is 45 points.
6. Overall total points is 65.
7. For Segment 1 (True or False and Multiple Choice), participants will CLICK "A" option for True or "B" option for False answer which can be seen on the ClassPoint window for the True or False questions. For the Multiple-Choice questions, the participants will CLICK the letter with the correct answer. Participants will be given 10 seconds to click their answers and CLICK "Submit". Note: "Thank you for your response! You have submitted" together with your answer will appear on screen after you clicked the "submit" button.
8. For Segment 2 (Fill in the Blanks or Completion), participants will have 15 seconds to write down their answers. Answers should be written in full, with no abbreviations or acronyms. Articles and prepositions should be correct. Answers with wrong spelling will be considered wrong. Each question in Segments 1 and 2 will be read twice. After the Quizmaster reads the question the second time, he/she will say "GO". Only then will the participants choose the correct answer from the options or type their answer on the space which can be seen on screen. When the options or space can no longer be seen on ClassPoint screen and they have not finished yet entering their answer, this means that the time allotted for each item is already up. The Quizmaster will read aloud the answers of each participant. The scores will record the answers accordingly. A cumulative score per participant will be announced by the Quizmaster after each round before moving on to the next segment.
9. The Organizing Committee and the Sub-Committee on Test development and Quiz Mechanics shall provide technical support and clarifications deemed necessary by the Board of Judges.
10. Scoring Systems. There will be two scoring systems to ensure the correctness of tabulations, to be handled by the Scoring Team designated by the Organizing Committee. These two-scoring systems are: (1) by computer, and (2) manually, using scoring sheets and a tabulation board prominently displayed for the reference of the participants, the Board of Judges, and coaches.
11. After the completion of segment 2, the cumulative points earned by each participant in the two segments will be tabulated. The results will be examined and verified by the Organizing Committee. When the results have been verified, these will be submitted to the board of Judges and announced accordingly by the Quizmaster.
12. The Chairman of the board of Judges shall declare the First, Second, and Third Place Winners. The first highest pointer shall represent the Regional Competition. The second and third place winners will be declared as an alternative in case the first is unable to go for the Regional Competition.
13. In case of a tie, tiebreaker question/s shall be asked until definite winner emerges. At the start of the tiebreaker round, the scores revert to zero.
14. Should there be questions or protests, the Board of Judges shall decide on the matter. Their decision is final.
