

Subject: INITIAL ASSESSMENT FOR EMERGENCY SCHOOL FEEDING, PSYCHOLOGICAL FIRST AID, AND OTHER HEALTH-RELATED NEEDS OF LEARNERS AND PERSONNEL AFFECTED BY TYPHOON ODETTE

In response to the massive impacts of Typhoon (TY) Odette to the education sector, the DepEd Central Office (CO) Quick Response and Recovery Team (QRRT) has been activated in accordance with **DepEd Order No. 44, s. 2018** or the “*Formation of the Department of Education Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Team in the Central Office*”.

Relative to this, the Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) instructs all concerned Regional and Division School Health and Nutrition (SHN) Personnel, with support from Youth Formation Coordinators and in close coordination with the DRRM Coordinators, to conduct a needs assessment for Emergency School Feeding (ESF) and Psychological First Aid (PFA) for learners and DepEd personnel affected by TY Odette. Other health-related needs can be included in the initial assessment.

For Schools Division Offices (SDOs)

1. The SDO SHN personnel, together with the SDO Youth Formation Coordinator and SDO DRRM Coordinator, shall assess the needs of the **learners and personnel in the affected schools** in their respective divisions as well as of **SDO personnel**, and accomplish the attached report template *Division Consolidated ESF, PFA, and Other Health-related Needs of Learners and School and SDO Personnel Affected by Typhoon Odette (Annex A)*.
2. The accomplished report shall be submitted to the SGOD Chief and Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) for review and approval.

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3. The SDO SHN Personnel shall submit the accomplished and approved Annex A (in PDF and Excel format) directly to BLSS-SHD at blss.shd@deped.gov.ph, copy furnish their respective Regional Offices (ROs), SDSs, SGOD Chiefs, SDO DRRM Coordinators, and SDO Youth Formation Coordinators, if possible, on or before 27 December 2021.

For Regional Offices (ROs)

1. The RO SHN personnel, together with the RO Youth Formation Coordinator and RO DRRM Coordinator, shall assess the PFA and other health-related needs of RO personnel and accomplish the attached reporting template *PFA and Other Health-related Needs of RO Personnel Affected by Typhoon Odette* (**Annex B**).
2. The accomplished report shall be submitted to the ESSD Chief and Regional Director (RD) for review and approval.
3. The RO SHN Personnel shall submit the accomplished and approved Annex B (in PDF and Excel format) to BLSS-SHD at blss.shd@deped.gov.ph, copy furnish their respective RDs, ESSD Chiefs, Regional DRRM Coordinators, and Regional Youth Formation Coordinators, if possible, on or before 27 December 2021.


The reports for submission on 27 December 2021 are considered as **initial assessments**, so field offices are enjoined to submit whatever data are available to them by the said date. Updated reports may still be submitted after the said initial deadlines, in consideration of the mobility and connectivity issues that may be experienced by the field offices following the typhoon.

The Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) shall consolidate all submissions from affected regions and divisions and transmit the same to Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS), copy furnish the External Partnerships Service (EPS), for mobilization of donations and assistance from partners.

Field visits will be conducted by the DepEd CO QRRT, including but not limited to SHD, Youth Formation Division (YFD), DRRMS, and EPS. Caraga region will be the first to be visited by the DepEd CO QRRT tentatively on 09-12 January 2022. Field visits in other affected regions shall be determined on a later date. The DRRMS shall coordinate with the concerned region/s and division/s regarding the field visits.
