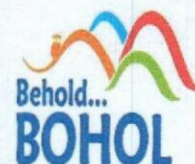

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

- Highest average score of all learners administered with the exam provided average score is at least 80%.
