1. Attached is the **DepEd Order No. 010 s. 2022, entitled Supplemental Guidelines On DepEd Order 031, s.2021**. This program of the Department of Education, thru the Bureau of Learner Support Services - School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) issued the said supplemental guidelines utilizing Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 Funds to ensure the coverage of target beneficiaries despite of the decrease in the budget allocation from 6 Billion to 2.3 Billion Pesos, this will address hunger and encourage learners to enroll, and may contribute to the health and nutritional status of the learners.
2. Attention is invited to the specific provisions and all its contents of the said DepEd Order.

SUPPLEMENTAL GUIDELINES ON DEPED ORDER NO. 031, S. 2021
(Operational Guidelines on the Implementation
of the School-Based Feeding Program)

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) issues this **Supplemental Guidelines on the Implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP)** using Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 Funds to ensure that its target beneficiaries will still be covered despite the huge decrease in the budget allocation from 6 Billion Pesos to 2.3 Billion Pesos.

2. For School Year (SY) 2021-2022 using FY 2022 funds, this supplemental guidelines on the specific provisions of DepEd Order (DO) No. 031, s. 2021 shall be followed:

a. Section II, Scope and Coverage

i. On A.2 Primary Beneficiaries

(I) The SBFP's primary beneficiaries shall be the same beneficiaries in SY 2021-2022 using FY 2021 Funds (all Kindergarten learners and SW and W in Grades 1 to 6 learners).

ii. On B. Duration

(I) The number of feeding days shall be 30 days for Nutritious Food Products (NFP) and 16 days for Pasteurized/Sterilized Milk Packs (PM/SMP) and the suggested implementation period is within April to July of SY 2021-2022 both for the NFP and milk components. Thus, the number of feeding days for SY 2021-2022 using FYs 2021 and 2022 Funds is 90 days for NFP and 49 days for Milk for a total of 139 days.

b. Section VII. Specifications and Quality Standards

i. On A. Technical Specifications of Nutritious Food Products

- (I) Please see Annex 1 – Revised Technical Specifications for

 - Milky Bun
 - Fortified/Enriched Bread

- d. Iron-Fortified rice for a maximum of 5 days (350g x 5 days)
- e. Nutri-packs

c. Section XI. Other Activities

i. On A. Nutritious Assessment

(1) Nutritional assessment may be conducted in May-June 2022 to establish the nutritional status of the beneficiaries at the end of the feeding period subject to the issuance of a memorandum depending on the community quarantine status by then.

3. The following documents are enclosed for reference:

- a. Enclosure No. 1 - Revised Technical Specifications for Nutritious Food Products, and
- b. Enclosure No. 2 - Breakdown of Allocation for Fiscal Year 2022 Funds

4. All other provisions in the existing guidelines on the DO 031, s. 2021 (Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program) shall remain in force, unless sooner repealed, amended, or rescinded.

5. Regional directors, schools divisions superintendents, and school heads are enjoined to extend full administrative support to the implementation of the SBFP.

6. This Order shall take effect upon its approval. Its certified copies will be filed with the University of the Philippines Law Center-Office of the Administrative Register (UP LC-ONAR), UP Diliman, Quezon City.
