


INTRODUCTION and RATIONALE


The Council of Student Chapters (CSC) of the Institute of the Integrated Electrical Engineers of the Philippines, Inc. (IIEE) brings forth a series of webinar to gather high school students from different regions across the archipelago. This is an event entitled, *EEnvestigation 2022: Seeking for Footprints of Future.*

To warmly provide great opportunity for the college year, the EEnvestigation 2022 is established with a primary intent of opening the minds of the high school students of what Electrical Engineering and Electrical Technology were all about, and what future breaks it can provide. Moreover, to guide them on exploring and preparing for College to consider choosing these degree programs.

The said event is divided into five series set for different regions. The webinar will be held during the Saturday afternoon of the specified months above. - April 30 (Grade 10-12 from Regions 9-10: Southern and Western Mindanao)


