Greetings!

The University of Asia and the Pacific is pleased to announce the resumption of the 23rd Civitas Asia National Student Conference with the theme SIBOL: A Quest in Promoting Ecological Urbanization in the New Normal tentatively on June 2 to 4, 2022 via virtual conference. This event will also be spearheaded by some of the Civic Student Interest Groups (SIGs) in the University, particularly UA&P SABIO, UA&P LOKAL, UA&P CATALYST and UA&P ALON.

Civitas Asia National Student Conference will continue to focus on five SDGs under the PROSPERITY category, namely SDGs 7 (Affordable and Clean Energy), 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth), 9 (Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure), 10 (Reduced Inequalities), and 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities).

For the **first day** of the conference, the delegates will equip themselves with a brief background of what the SDGs are, which will be followed by an in-depth discussion on **SDG 7 and 10**. The culmination will be a talk on the basics of policy proposal making. The **second day** will be dedicated to talks which will enlighten the youth about the economy's role in the preservation of our ecosystem, as well as the effects that our actions make, and our responsibility as explorers towards ecological urbanization. On the same day, talks on the **remaining SDGs**, **i.e. SDG 8, 9, and 10**, will also be discussed. As their output, the delegates may compete by crafting a policy brief related to the discussed SDGs, which they will submit to a panel of judges. The awarding of the winning policy proposal will be done through the official social media accounts of civAsia.

By of the end of three-day conference, civAsia aims to impart among its participants (1) a deeper understanding of the problems that affect the Philippine economy; (2) the knowledge to help remedy these dilemmas, and (3) the realization of the urgency in solving these problems concerning economic growth, which leads to the development of a sustainable community.

Kindly note that all talks and workshops are open for both high school and college students. However, participation in the writing competition is limited to high school participants only.



With all of this being said, civAsia and the Center for Student Affairs (CSA) identify a vast connection between the principles it stands for with the vision and mission of your institution. Because of this, the Civitas Asia National Student Conference would like to formally invite your school to participate in this year's events and learning activities as a way to further enrich ourselves.

Registration fee for high school participants is at Php 150 per group for public schools and Php 300 per group for private schools. Each group may have a minimum of 2 and a maximum or 4 participants. Meanwhile, the registration fee for college students is at Php 150 per head.

Any other updates on the commencement of the conference, apart from what is mentioned in the letter, will be sent upon notification and approval of the organizing team.
