We are happy to extend the possibilities of reaching out our out-of-school youth in nearby municipalities of Tagbilaran - Cortes, Corella, Dausis, and Baclayon. We would like to offer Tagbilaran City's existing second-chance opportunities programs for selected ALS completers, ages 15-24 years old and who have completed the ALS Life Skills Modules in the said municipalities.

Opportunities 2.0 is a 5-year project funded by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and there are three service providers (University of Bohol, YouthLead Phils., and Bohol Integrated Development Foundation) willing to offer free training and materials for our youth to accompany them in harnessing their skills for employability, livelihood, and choose higher level of education.

Requesting your good office to allow our local service providers coordinate with ALS Mobile Teachers assigned in the CLCs in the said municipalities for the recruitment and list of qualified learners. We were thankful to meet Dr. Evelyn Codilla, DepEd Bohol ALS Focal Coordinator last Monday. We introduced to her the local service providers' program/project managers, the learning interventions and activities that the youth will undergo, and the number of ALS completers who can enroll in the program (to be catered by the three local service providers).
