Dear Dr. Dagatan:

Greetings from the Diocese of Tagbilaran! We pray you are in the best of health and safety.

We are happy to inform you that the Diocese is currently undertaking a cultural development project for the youth of the province in different parishes across both dioceses aimed at strengthening positive values, cultural identity, and social awareness so that they grow up to be God-loving and fearing, socially responsible, and empowered adults.

Currently, we are promoting the lives of two Spanish friars, BLESSED JOSE RADA and BLESSED LEON INCHAUSTI, both priests from the Order of the Augustinian Recollects who served as parish priests in 7 towns of Bohol in the late 19<sup>th</sup> century. Their lives were examples of dedication and commitment to the spiritual growth of the Bohol communities during their almost two decades-long stay in our province. After continuing their missionary work in Brazil, they returned to Spain in the midst of the Civil War where they suffered martyrdom in the hands of the Communist rebels. In 1997, they were raised to the status of BLESSED, and are currently being promoted for elevation to sainthood. The Diocese of Tagbilaran has launched a cultural program for the youth that will portray the lives of these two Blessed, entitled PAINGON SA PAGKASANTOS.



In this connection, we are inviting the DEP ED Bohol Schools Division through the ALS Program to send youths to participate in this project in 5 towns (Loay, Candijay, Carmen, Pilar, and Ubay). Open to 10 ALS student youths per town, they will be provided the following significant learning experiences:

- 3 day training in arts and culture
- 10 day rehearsals and production

With these experiences, we envision that they attain the following objectives:

- Gain stronger consciousness of Bohol culture and history
- Strengthen social and spiritual values
- Acquire knowledge and skills in the creative industries focused on theater production (acting), production management (stage and technical theater),
