Subject: **IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REGULAR COMPONENT OF THE SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM FOR F.Y. 2022 AND GRANT OF SERVICE CREDITS TO SBFP IMPLEMENTERS**

- I. DepEd Order 31, s. 2021, or the “Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program” and DepEd Order 10, s. 2022 or the “Supplemental Guidelines on DepEd Order 031, S. 2021” provided for the direction on the implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program with Milk Feeding Component for the School Year 2021-2022.
- II. The funds for the Regular Component have already been downloaded to the majority of schools in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> week of May 2022. Hence, all nine hundred and thirty-three (933) SBFP implementing schools are directed to **initiate** as soon as possible **the implementation** of the **SBFP Regular Component** through the distribution of the nutritious food products (NFP).
- III. Furthermore, Item D of Section XI of DepEd Order 31, s. 2021 prescribes the following:
  - **Granting of Service Credits to SBFP Coordinators and School Feeding Coordinators/ Implementers**

*The services rendered by SBFP implementers beyond the required eight hours of service or during weekends and holidays are eligible for service credits in accordance with the provisions of DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003. The School Heads are responsible for requesting such incentives for approval by the SDS.*



- IV. In view of the said, all school heads of SBFP implementing schools are enjoined to take responsibility and facilitate in the **requesting of the grant of service credits** for the School Feeding Coordinator and teachers who participate directly in the implementation of the SBFP in the school pursuant to the aforementioned issuance.
- V. The requesting of the said service credits will be made by the concerned schools to the SDO after the completion of both the regular and milk feeding component of the SBFP of the current school year.
- VI. For the information, dissemination, and compliance of all concerned.
