 - v. Copy of Sining sa Eskwela, 2017-2019 or 2021 (virtual edition) CCP Arts Academy, and other recognized training certificates as proof of attendance on arts training programs, and
 - c. Former attendees- pre-qualified but still subject to screening and approval.





Greetings from the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP)!

The CCP through its Arts Education Department will conduct a series of workshops under the 2022 CCP Arts Academy, for teachers of Senior High School (SHS) Arts and Design Track, SHS's Core Subjects with Humanities and Arts related competencies and the Special Program in the Arts (SPA) from July 31 – August 6, 2022 at the Silliman University, Dumaguete City, Negros Oriental. The Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP) and the Department of Education (dated September 23, 2016), agreed to collaboratively undertake trainings and other relevant activities for the K to 12 program", and "...to support the K-12 Arts and Design Trainings and other relevant activities that CCP may undertake for the K to 12 programs through the issuance of memoranda..."

The 2022 CCP Arts Academy is especially designed to provide teachers (non-beginners) with professional and specialized training on their respective art forms, to build their capacities and advance their artistic development by focusing on production and performance techniques, principles/processes, arts knowledge and skills, and pedagogical approaches. Only 30 teachers per module.

Preference will be given to teacher-applicants from public and private schools who are actively engaged in creative and artistic/management productions/activities by mounting artistic productions/ exhibitions, attending major arts festivals (national and international) and winning artistic awards and recognitions; or who are actively engaged in mentoring / coaching students in the arts, for recent competitions such as NAMCYA, National Festival of Talents (NFOT) and other national and international competitions/exhibitions in the different fields of art.

In view of the above, we would like to request for an issuance of a Memorandum for this arts education training program. The 2022 CCP Arts Academy shall consist of workshops and training modules to be facilitated by teacher-artists and practitioners from the CCP's pool of local and national partners. Please see attachment of the proposed workshop modules (Annex A).

The applicants must submit the following on or before July 8, 2022:

- a. Completed individual application form provided in the enclosure; and
- b. For new applicants, portfolio of the following to determine appropriateness of level:

i. supporting documents of most recent productions/exhibits mounted

ii. supporting documents of most recent major arts festivals (local/national/international)

attended

iii. supporting documents of arts related awards and recognitions received iv. List and contact number of artists and artists groups that the teachers worked with, for reference purposes.

- v. Copy of Sining sa Eskwela, 2017-2019 or 2021 (Virtual Edition) CCP Arts Academy, and other recognized training certificates as proof of attendance on arts training programs; and
- c. Former attendees Pre-qualified but still subject for screening and approval.

Each accepted applicant shall be charged a registration fee of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P7,500) to cover board and lodging with two (2) meals per day, workshop kits, training laboratory use and materials for the duration of the workshop for the participants. A subscription of the CCP Digital Encyclopedia of Philippine Art shall be included in the provisions.

- a. Registration, transportation, board and lodging and other expenses shall be charged to School MOOE/Division/Region funds, school board funds (SBF) and other sources and grants, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- b. Advance payment may be deposited after receiving the official notification of acceptance from the CCP/Silliman Secretariat.

Teachers shall receive appropriate service credits as stipulated in DepEd Order (DO) No. 53, s. 2003 entitled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers, and DO 84 s. 2003 entitled Addendum to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003(Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers).

Walk-in applicants will not be entertained. They are required to submit their applications directly to the CCP Arts Academy Secretariat using their personal and registered email add. Authorized representatives are not allowed to communicate and process applications on behalf of the interested participants.
