Subject: **REITERATION OF THE DEPED BOHOL HEALTH ALERT SYSTEM**

- I. Division Memorandum No. DM No. 169, s. 2020, entitled “Health Event and Incident Reporting System,” and Division Memorandum No. DM No. 090, s. 2021, or the “Updated Link to the Health Events Reporting System and the Submission of the School Health Registry,” laid out the reporting of notifiable health events involving learners and personnel of the Department of Education, Division of Bohol through the Health Events Reporting System. The same system was renamed “**DepEd Bohol Health Alert System.**”
- II. The online system aims to achieve both active and passive surveillance practices concerning notifiable events and incidents on top of already existing reporting mechanisms in schools and offices. Once reported, a notifiable incident or event will be recorded and processed by the School Health and Nutrition Section of the Schools Division Office for documentation and appropriate action.
- III. It is, therefore, reiterated that the **DepEd Bohol Health Alert System** continues to be the official online means for the reporting of notifiable events affecting DepEd Bohol learners and personnel in the present and for S.Y. 2022-2023 by all public elementary and secondary schools in the division.
- IV. The following are the notifiable events and incidents affecting DepEd Bohol learners and personnel that may be reported through the Health Alert System:
  - a) Adverse reactions following deworming
  - b) Adverse reactions following immunization

- c) Alleged spirit possession
- d) COVID cases (reroutes to the CORE online reporting mechanism)
- e) Death of learner or personnel
- f) Dengue cases
- g) Drowning/near-drowning incidents
- h) Drug-related incidents
- i) Food poisoning incidents
- j) Gender-based violence
- k) Leprosy cases
- l) Lifestyle-related disease cases (such as stroke, heart attack, etc.)
- m) Measles cases
- n) Mental health-related incidents
- o) Motor-vehicular accident
- p) Rabies cases
- q) Suicide attempt
- r) Teenage parenthood among male learners
- s) Teenage pregnancies among learners
- t) Tuberculosis cases
- u) Other cases as may be reported

V. All concerned are therefore enjoined to report the aforesaid notifiable incidents affecting DepEd Bohol learners and personnel promptly to the **Health Alert System** via the following link:
