- 4. In connection to the above, PSDSs are encouraged to continue the provision of technical assistance to schools to improve practices on identified improvement areas. Likewise, the Division Field Technical Assistance Team shall also continue to provide random technical assistance to schools where needed.
- 5. Meanwhile, the DFTAT would like to express its appreciation to schools visited that show documentations of its practices placed in their SBM portfolios.

MORATORIUM ON THE CONDUCT OF DIVISION AND REGIONAL SCHOOL-BASED MANAGEMENT VALIDATION ACTIVITIES

To: Undersecretaries Assistant Secretaries Bureau and Service Directors Regional Directors Schools Division Superintendents Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

- With reference to the ongoing policy development of the revised guidelines on the implementation of the DepEd School-Based Management (SBM) Framework, all ongoing and planned activities relative to the conduct of the validation process with the purpose of determining the SBM Level of Practice by the schools division offices (SDOs) and regional offices (ROs) shall be held in abeyance.
- This moratorium is issued to prepare and assist field offices and schools in their gradual transition from DepEd Order No. 83, s. 2012 (Implementing Guidelines on the Revised School-Based Management [SBM] Framework, Assessment Process And Tool [APAT]) to the new SBM policy.
- During this period, field offices shall observe a practice-based provision of technical assistance in lieu of recognition-based validation activities.
 - SDOs shall provide the necessary technical assistance for a. continuous improvement of school practices and processes on areas identified as dimensions of school operations,

ROs shall extend support and trainings to their SDOs to enhance capacity in providing technical assistance to schools, and

- c. SDOs and ROs shall strengthen and further develop their tools and mechanisms to ensure relevance and enhance the efficiency of the provision of their respective technical assistance.
- Meanwhile, schools shall continue to undergo self-assessment using the existing SBM tool with the purpose of identifying areas for improvement in the following dimensions of school operations:
 - Leadership,
 - Governance and Accountability,
 - Human Resources and Team Development,
 - d. Finance and Resource Management and Mobilization,
 - Curriculum and Instruction, and c.
 - Learning Environment. f.

- 5. This moratorium shall remain in effect until the new SBM policy is issued.
- 6.
