The event will be held at the *Oakbrook Children's Library & Museum* on *November 4, 2022, Friday*, from 8:30 A.M. to 11:30 A.M. with the theme: "**LEAD WITH COMPASSION**". This activity aims to provide young individuals coming from different schools, an avenue to express how they envision peace through art and creativity. The young artists are encouraged to portray their life experience and culture in line with the theme. It will be participated by the different LCI districts and chapters worldwide.

The contest will be judged according to originality, artistic merit, as well as, creative expression of the theme. The entries will advance through a series of judging levels: local, district, multi-district up to the international level. All district winners will move to the international level.

The local level prizes are as follows:

- 1st Prize** – Php 2,000.00
- 2nd Prize** – Php 1,500.00
- 3rd Prize** – Php 1,000.00

The district level prizes are as follows:

- 1st Prize** – Php 5,000.00
- 2nd Prize** – Php 3,000.00
- 3rd Prize** – Php 1,500.00

At the international level, judges from the art, peace, youth, education, and media communities select one grand prize winner and 23 merit award winners. One grand prize winner will receive an award and US \$5,000.00.

Deadline for the upcoming events are as follows:

- November 12, 2022** – Submission of one winning peace poster.
- November 23 – 25, 2022** – Judging and announcement of district winners.
- February 1, 2023** – Notification of international winners.
