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PROVINCIAL GIRL SCOUTS GOT TALENT 2022

December 19, 2022 (Monday)

Theme: "The Girls Vision: A Sustainable World For All"

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Contestants to the Provincial Girl Scouts Got Talent (PGSGT) 2022 must be the declared First Prize Winners of the different contest categories during their Area Level - Girl Scouts Got Talent (GSGT).
2. Contestants must not be first prize winners of the previous PGSGT vying in the same category/level where they had won.
3. Contestants must be registered Girl Scouts who will vie under one category only under her appropriate age level.
4. Contestants must wear the complete Girl Scout - Formal Dress Uniform (with scarf and pins) except for the Interpretative Dance contestants who must wear the Active Wear Uniform (logo shirt, bermuda shorts with green socks & rubber shoes).
5. District Field Advisers (DFAs) of the host districts during the Area Level competition must submit to the Council a copy of the Area Level Results with the following details: Contest Category, Name of Contestant/Winner, Age Level, Troop Number, Date of Registration, and Name of Troop Leader.

The following documents of the first placers must also be submitted:

- a. Photocopies of the Troop Registration Form with Official Receipt
 - b. Copy of the Twinkler Poem in Word file
 - c. Copy of the lyrics of the song (Song Writing - Senior) in Word file
6. Contestants, together with the District Field Advisers, must be at the venue before the program starts for the Registration of Contestants, and Drawing of Lots for the order of performance. Refer to Council Circular #21, S.2021 for the Time Schedule.
 7. Contestants must be at the venue during the Opening Program of the competition.
 8. Contestants must abide by the above-mentioned general guidelines, and contest guidelines.
 9. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.

SONG WRITING	<p>Original song composition of the contestant in English about being a Girl Scout</p> <p>Minus one accompaniment.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The song must be an original composition/work of the Senior Contestant around the theme of being a Girl Scout. ▪ Lyrics of the song must be in English. One or a combination of the musical instruments may be used. ▪ The song could be any genre which must not exceed five (5) minutes, inclusive of intro and outro. ▪ The contestant must sing the song she composed with a minus accompaniment. <p>30% - Musicality 30% - Lyrics/Message (Relevance to the theme) 25% - Creativity 15% - Stage Presence</p>

CADET LEVEL - Open to all registered Cadet Girl Scouts (Grades 11 to 12 and College)

Guitar Solo	<p>Nylon-string guitar (no steel-string acoustic or electric guitars)</p> <p>Contestant's Choice - Any piece/style of music can be played.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The Cadet Contestant must use a nylon-string guitar (no steel-string acoustic or electric guitars). ▪ Use of a plectrum/pick will not be allowed. ▪ Contestants must play one (1) music/song only (no medley) with any piece or style of music. ▪ Performance must be limited to not more than five (5) minutes. <p>30% - Musicality 30% - Difficulty of piece 30% - Techniques and posture 10% - Stage Presence</p>
SPOKEN POETRY	<p>Original composition of the contestant from a predetermined topic</p> <p>Pad paper and writing pen</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The Cadet Contestant will be given a total of four (4) hours to compose and memorize her Spoken Poetry in English. ▪ The piece must be delivered/performed within 3 to 5 minutes. Little movements/gestures will be allowed. ▪ One (1) point deduction shall be made if the contestant finishes the delivery more than the allowed time frame. ▪ Sounds, instrumental or musical background will be allowed to complement the delivery. <p>40% - Message/Content 30% - Delivery and Performance 15% - Memorization 15% - Voice Variation and Projection</p>
