MECHANICS:

- The Competition is open to all high school and college students in the Province of Bohol, not limiting to the number of entries per school.
- The musical composition entry must be an original work of the contestant and must not have been previously recorded, published, used in any previous competitions, commissioned by a third party, or have been commercially released in any part of the world.
- The genre could be any of the following: pop, jazz, ballad, classical, blues, soul, rock or R & B. There is no limit as to number of collaborators per song.
- Lyrics of the song must be in Visayan-Cebuano, Visayan-Filipino, Visayan-English or a combination of those. Profanity, explicit or vulgar words, violent content, and registered trademarks or brand names are strictly prohibited in the lyrics.
- Entry song must not exceed four (4) minutes and must not be less than three (3) minutes, inclusive of intro and outro. For accompaniment, one (1) or a combination of musical instruments may be used.
- Downloadable entry forms are available at the Facebook.com/ Himo'g Huni. Demos can be recorded via mobile phones, as long as the audio - voice and chord progression - is decently audible.
- The following are to be submitted, placed in one (1) folder per entry:
 - Filled out entry form;
 - Recorded entry in ".mp3" format with vocals and accompaniment;
 - Typewritten lyrics in Microsoft Word Document; and
 - Certification from school head
- Failure to comply with any of the above requirements shall be a ground for disqualification.
- Deadline of the submission of entries is on March 13, 2023, on or before noontime. Entries submitted shall be subject for screening to determine the ten (10) finalists that will compete during the final performance night.

- All entries shall be considered final once submitted and cannot be modified or altered.
- In the event that an entry has been selected as finalist, the Himo'g Huni Committee shall have unlimited right, worldwide and in perpetuity, to use, re-arrange, and make improvements to the musical composition.
- The Top 10 entries will be posted on the Himo'g Huni Facebook account and may be shared. Entries with the most number of "likes" will be credited as part of the audience rapport element of the criteria.
- All composers and interpreters must attend all scheduled rehearsals prepared and coordinated by the Himo'g Huni Committee, especially the finals' night calendared for April 23, 2023 at the Bohol Cultural Center.
- All entries shall be judged according to the set criteria for judging below:

• Lyrics and Melody	- 60%
• Overall Musicality	- 20%
• Overall Impression	- 10%
• Interpretation	- 5%
• Audience Appeal	- 5%

- Decision of the Board of Judges, across all stages of this competition, shall be final and unappealable.
- Winners will be awarded the following cash prizes:

• Grand Winner	- P30,000
• 1st Runner-Up	- P20,000
• 2nd Runner-Up	- P15,000
• Consolation Prizes	- P10,000
