	Creativity (35%)  - The poster's visual and artistic value. The poster employs the use of indigenous and recycled materials among other means of displaying creativity and resourcefulness.
	Slogan (25%)  - The slogan depicted in the poster is able to describe with brevity the program(s) focused on the piece. The slogan may use English, Filipino, or the mother tongue medium.
