Dualtech Center is now accepting High School Graduates, ALS Passers/Completer and College Levels through **2 year Electromechanics Technoogy**. Students will spent **6-months of in-school training** for actual electrical, electronics and mechanical skills. The next **18-months will be spent for in-plant/company training**- they will receive minimum monthly allowance of 75% of the minimum wage for their transportation, meals and other needs. - * Physically fit (as stated on medical certificate)

Requirements are:

- * ORIGINAL high school report card or F137a or transcript of records or ALS certificate
- * PHOTOCOPIED high school diploma and birth certificate
- * Medical Certificate with FIT TO WORK result from accredited DOH clinic, laboratory or hospital (with tests on CBC, urinalysis, fecalysis, chest x-ray, Hepa B screening and physical examination from the doctor)

Scholarship programs, support, financial assistance and loans are available to qualified and deserving youth until March 31, 2023.
