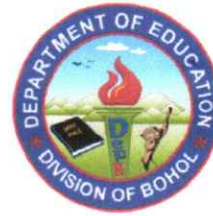

**CONDUCT OF 2023 DOST-SEI CLIMATE SCIENCE YOUTH CAMP IN BOHOL**

2. The Climate Science Youth Camp (CSYC) aims to promote oceanography and meteorology as fields of study and as a career to strengthen the S&T human resource in the country.
3. The activity entails the participation of **two (2) Grade 8 or 9 students per school (1 male, 1 female) and one (1) accompanying science/math major school head or program head.** The participation of teachers is prohibited to ensure that no classes are sacrificed.
4. The schools involved are requested to submit a catch-up plan to facilitate the continuity of learning on days when students are out of the classroom and make sure that parental consent is secured. 5. DOST-SEI shall shoulder all expenses relative to the conduct of the CSYC such as transportation, accommodation, and meals of participants.
