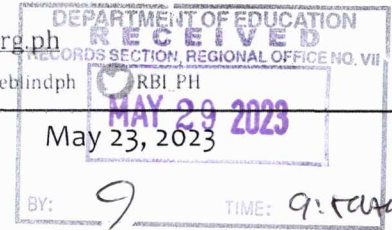

Greetings from Resources for the Blind, Inc.

In our goal of helping children with visual impairment reach their full potential, we are confronted with the challenge of providing sustainable eye care services. Our office is continuously finding ways to address the various need of children with visual impairment through our programs and services even in the midst and post pandemic.

In view of this, we would like to inform you that our Low Vision Field Coordinator, Ms. Mycell Importante together with the Low Vision Interns will be conducting eye screening including students with disabilities. This activity is in partnership with the Inclusive Eye Health Cluster (DOH-EHFI-CBM-RBI) of the IEH Program. Identified students with visual acuity on both eyes of 20/80 or EOR +1.50 up and low vision will be provided with spectacles and low vision devices after clinical assessment to our trained low vision clinician, Dr. Candy Delos Reyes. Those students needing eye surgery will be referred to our partner ophthalmologist and Eye Hear Foundation, Inc. We will furnish a copy of the result data of the activity and reference of the schedule of low vision assessment to identified students.

In addition, yours truly will visit the SPED VI to assess the educational needs of students with visual impairment and provide possible technical support to the trained teachers in SPED VI under the previous collaborative training program of DepED-CNU-RBI summer training institute. The visit and eye screening will start on May 31, 2023 until month of September 2023 to selected schools with SPED. Attached is the list of schools with SPED program re: schedule of eye screening and visit for reference.
