This pertains to the Joint Review Mission of the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and DepEd for the EdTech Solutions for Last Mile Schools in COVID-19 that supports the operationalization of the Basic Education – Learning Continuity Plan by providing access to facilities and resources that will enable students to continue learning through distance education amidst the COVID-19 pandemic. It also covers the

provision of capacity building and learning resources for schools and teachers to aid them in teaching delivery under technology-enabled blended learning modalities.

To monitor and validate the progress and challenges/ bottlenecks being encountered by the project as well as to document the best practices for possible future project interventions, a review mission will be conducted which involves field visits to the project beneficiaries. The specific objectives of the said mission are the following:

- a. discuss progress of the TA with Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and school administration and review the past/ current activities and any outstanding TA administration issues;
- b. review and discuss the progress towards achieving the design and monitoring framework; and
- c. discuss any other issues that may be raised.

A team composed of staff from the Project Management Service (PMS) and ADB representatives will be deployed to the **SDOs of Abra, Kalinga, Bohol, and Zamboanga Sibugay**, namely:

The team shall conduct key informant interviews and focused group discussions with the concerned school personnel (school head, teachers, and ICT [Information and Communications Technology] focal) and SDO staff (ICT and Curriculum and Learning Management Division [CLMD] focals), as well as with the students, pertaining to the implementation of the project and its sustainability.
