



ORIENTATION-TRAINING ON PROJECT DULA AND THE UNDERPINNINGS OF LITERACY

To: Schools Division Superintendents (SDSs)

All Others Concerned

1. In its effort to sustain the proper implementation of curriculum in Kindergarten, and Special Needs Education, this Office, through Curriculum and Learning Management Division, initiates Project DULA which aimed to develop and unleash learners' abilities through Play. This is composed of a learning package of inclusive and developmentally-appropriate activities for all types of kindergarten learners, and digitized materials for teachers to utilize during the delivery of the lesson. In line with this, an Orientation-Training on Project DULA, and the Underpinnings of Literacy shall be conducted on August 7-12, 2023 at DepEd Ecotech Center, Lahug, Cebu City.

2. The activity aims to:

- a. launch RO7 Enhanced Kindergarten Blocks-of-Time (RO7-eKBT) under Project DULA;
- b. orient the participants on the components of Project DULA and its utilization; and
- c. reskill and upskill the participants on the underpinnings of literacy, playing ukulele, and Filipino Sign Language.

3. Each school division office is expected to send 11 participants who possess excellent facilitation skills, and with background knowledge in early childhood and special needs education, who shall compose the Division Core Team. They are the following:

1. Education Program Supervisor in Kindergarten
2. Division SPED Focal Person
3. 1 PSDS
4. 2 principals
5. 2 master teachers (preferably kindergarten)
6. 2 sped teachers (must be good in Filipino Sign Language)
7. 1 Ukulele expert
8. 1 kindergarten teacher

4. Participants are expected to bring laptops, hard copy of the assigned eKBT-DULA of their division, ukulele, and Filipino Sign Language Videos. They are requested to pre-register through this link: <https://forms.gle/AfmJ78bKmFxKnxxm7>

This shall be participated in by the members of Technical Working Team and identified facilitators, stipulated in enclosure number 1. Likewise, a pre-work conference shall be conducted on **August 6, 2023**, to be attended by all resource speakers and or facilitators and technical working team..
6. Please see enclosure number 2 for the activity matrix. First meal to be served for **Program Management Team** is dinner of August 6, 2023, and last meal is breakfast of August 12, 2023. While first meal to be served for the **participants** is lunch of August 7, 2023, and last meal is breakfast of August 12, 2023.
7. Service Credits and or Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) shall be granted to the participants in accordance to DepEd Order 53 s. 2003, entitled "Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Credits to Teachers," and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2 s. 2004 entitled "Policies and Guidelines on Overtime and Overtime Pay for Government Employees," respectively.
8. Board and lodging, venue and other incidental expenses incurred relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against (OSEC - 7-23-1696) 2023 SPED-PSF while travel and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants shall be charged against 2023 SPED-PSF downloaded to the divisions, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
