The Girl Scouts of the Philippines, Bohol Girl Scout Council is pleased to announce the conduct of the Josefa Llanes Escoda (JLE) School/District Camp which shall be held on weekends (Saturday and Sunday) or Holidays within the months of October to December 2023. With the Council theme, "75 Years of Empowering Girls and Young Women: Celebrating Our Legacy, Inspiring Our Future", the JLE School/District Camp shall be geared towards the objectives of Girl Scouting through its program of citizenship training and character-building with activities in community development projects.

Girl Scout Camping is the Girl Scout Program carried out in the camp situation. It is defined as a "recreational experience out-of-doors which provides special opportunity for education and for social adjustment through group living." In line with the aims of the movement, below are the camping objectives:

1. To stimulate real enjoyment and appreciation out-of-doors through progressive camping experiences.
2. To develop resourcefulness, initiative and self-reliance.
3. To provide new and interesting experience with the opportunity for acquiring new skills.
4. To develop the individual's physical and mental well being.
5. To help a girl in her ability to be an accepted and adjusted member of a group.
6. To foster international friendship.

Suggested and Possible Activities

Handcrafts, Arts, Nature Lore, Community Service, Hikes, Song and Dance, Sports, Games (Scout Games, Wide Games, Team Games, Singing Games), Tree Planting, Non-Utensil Cooking, Anti-Dengue Campaign, Membership Campaign, Girl Scouts Got Talent.
