SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS AND SUSPENSION OF WORK IN ALL GOVERNMENT OFFICES ON NOVEMBER 17, 2023

In the wake of weather disturbance that has entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) heightened by the Northeast Monsoon and Shear Line and with the YELLOW Heavy Rainfall Warnings from PAGASA, classes in all levels in public and private schools and work in all government offices in the province will be suspended tomorrow, November 17, 2023. Private establishments are given the discretion to declare suspension of work for their employees.

However, offices whose functions involve the delivery of health services, preparedness and response to disaster and calamities, and/or performance of vital functions shall continue with their operations.

Moreover, classes for colleges and universities will also be suspended on Saturday, November 18, 2023. This is because PAGASA foresees intensification of rainfall towards the weekend.

The suspension of classes and work in government offices is a preventive step for all Boholanos, primarily to ensure their safety and for them to be with their respective families in this hydrometeorological hazard. Residents, especially those living in low-lying and coastal areas, are advised to take extra precaution against the threat of flooding and/or landslides.

The municipal mayors with their respective MDRRMCs are also directed to conduct unrelenting monitoring of the status of their respective AORs.
