H. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

Red Cross Youth (RCY) is known nationwide as one of the prime movers for youth empowerment and developing the youth leaders through various training and activities offered by the Red Cross Youth Services. As such, the Chapter Youth Council was formulated to enhance the skills and capabilities of the youth.

The Chapter Youth Council is the supreme deliberative body of the Red Cross Youth Bohol Chapter which helped enhance the youth's spirit in humanitarian and social services by giving them opportunities to participate in youth programs. One of these youth programs is the Chapter Youth Assembly which is held biennially. Participated by our active and committed RCY Volunteers with their respective Advisers all over Bohol, the objectives are: **(1) to discuss and collaborate on strategies and plans needed to come up with a solution for relevant issues and concerns that each council has encountered; (2) formulate and share the best practices and ways practiced by each council in intensifying the Volunteers' morale, self-worth, dignity and assessing the quality of leadership among the RCY's in Bohol Chapter; and (3) develop advocacies for the youth programs.** The Chapter Youth Assembly is also conducted to improve the youth Volunteers' skills not only in leadership but also in decision making, awareness and practice of social responsibility.

With this, the Red Cross Youth-Bohol Chapter will be holding the 8th Chapter Youth Assembly to encourage as well as provide opportunities among youth Volunteers who hold a position in the Chapter Youth Council.

I. GENERAL OBJECTIVES

The main objective of the Chapter Youth Assembly is to work hand in hand with the Philippine Red Cross-Bohol Chapter, mainly the Red Cross Youth Services, to enhance, improve and further develop the spirit of Volunteerism and humanitarian service of the Red Cross Youth Volunteers and their respective Council Advisers as well as empower them with their rights and privileges contributing for the best for the Red Cross Youth Bohol.

Specific Objectives:

1. To elect a new set of Chapter Youth Council Officers for Administrative Year 2023-2025;
2. To create a Plan of Action for the next CYC A.Y. 2023-2025;
3. To update each council with the new trends and activities;
4. Strategic Planning of the League of Advisers;
5. To work with Philippine Red Cross-Bohol Chapter in the formulation of policies and in management of youth programs;
6. To assist, advise and serve as focal point of coordination to all Junior Red Cross

7. (JRC), Senior Red Cross Youth (SRCY), College Red Cross Youth (CRCY) and Community Red Cross Youth (CommRCY) Councils.

J. METHODOLOGY

The 8th Chapter Youth Assembly is a 1 day activity involving the topics of the youth in preparation of the next generation's leaders. Such topics will prepare the youth by assessing their skills through Social Media usage, enhancing their knowledge on the Parliamentary Rules and Procedures as well as Resolution Making, acknowledging the respective Councils' Challenges faced and addressing these challenges as well as strategizing Volunteer Retention. Other topics will serve as information dissemination and skills and capabilities assessment on how councils and individual youth can be empowered through Event Organizing, application on Social Protocols and Guidelines and Youth Leadership Scheme.

Proposed Nomination Procedure:

1. Call for candidates via Google Form
2. Post via Facebook
3. Interested participants will be invited for screening via Zoom
4. Participants who passed during the initial online screening will be invited for a face-to-face orientation.

B. QUALIFICATIONS

All interested participants must meet the following qualifications to apply.

Delegate

- Must be 15 – 28 years of age
- Must be a bona fide member and volunteer of the Philippine Red Cross Bohol Chapter
- Must have completed the Youth Volunteer Formation Course– YVFC (**strictly required**)
- Must have been actively involved in RCY activities for a minimum of one (1) year (**strictly required**)

Observer

- Must be 12 – 30 years of age
- Must be a bona fide member and volunteer of the Philippine Red Cross Bohol Chapter
- Must have Completed the Leadership Development Program – LDP
- Must be actively involved in RCY activities for at least one (1) year

Council Adviser

- Must have attended a Council Management Training (optional for the new advisers and newly established councils)
- Must provide a certification of being an RCY Council Adviser duly signed by the University President/ Campus Director/ Campus or School Director/ School Principal

C. SCREENING OF PARTICIPANTS

- **Participants**
 - Comply and pass all the necessary requirements.
- **Secretariat Committee**
 - Check and oversee the authenticity of the submitted papers of the participants.
 - Will send a message via facebook or text message, confirming the participation of the 8th Chapter Youth Assembly.
 - Send reminders and updates (if any) to the participants.

A screening committee shall be created to ensure that all participants to the Chapter Youth Assembly are fully qualified to participate and contribute to the objectives of the Assembly.

All documents must be received by the Chapter Youth Council on or before **December 17 ,2023**. Councils who were not able to register on-time will have to register on-site at the official venue.

Read the Note: New RCY Volunteers could participate as delegates or observers as long as she/he will sign the 'oath of commitment'.

D. NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES FOR CHAPTER YOUTH COUNCIL

RCY volunteers who will run for the Chapter Youth Council position must fill-up the official nomination form duly signed by the nominee that shall be submitted to the committee on Nominations and Elections before the nomination deadline as set by the aforementioned committee.

Last day of submission of Nomination Forms will be on December 17, 2023, provided that all documents and forms have been duly accomplished and/or with the approval of his/her Council.

The registration fee, aside from cited above, shall cover the meals for the whole duration of the Assembly, souvenir items, as well as materials necessary for their participation in the different activities of the Assembly.

The registration fee will not cover travelling expenses from the school council origin to the venue and vice versa. Travel expenses shall be borne by the participants themselves. However, they may seek sponsorship from his/her school or community, civic organizations, Local government units or the school council funds if available.

Changing of ID's for whatever reason (i.e. change of delegation on-site from what was confirmed, etc.) will be charged Fifty Pesos only (Php 50.00).

For those participants who doesn't have a Red Cross Membership ID there will be an additional payment of P150.00 for Bronze or P60.00 for Classic
