Brief Description: This program shall focus on the nature of inviting students in schools to establish SCA cells in the representing schools. Reflections, Inputs on the realities of the youth, SCA Inputs, and helpful activities shall be given to prepare the participants who will then be the facilitators and organizers back in their campuses and diocese.

SCAfe Learning Objectives: *At the end of the program, the participants will be able to:*

- Identify and appreciate the role of SCA in fulfilling the mission and vision of our government in youth development and in uniting with the Church's Mission of Accompanying the youth.
- Develop organizational, formation, and advocacy plan for the unit/diocese using SCA Methodology and Cell System.
- Create a community of Christian leaders through commitment to organize and serve SCA local units and diocese.
- Facilitate and run SCA Cell Meeting Modules.

Nature and Methodology of the Formation:

The SCAfe uses the experiential method wherein the participants will personally experience participating in cell meeting activities following the process of preparing, implementing, and monitoring SCA in their respective school or parish. This is going to be a workshop wherein the facilitator will guide the participants through questions, templates, and reading materials. Active workshop activities are prepared for the participants to be more involved in the process. As accompaniment of youth is the key challenge in the current Campus Ministry concerns, this will also be tackled in the workshop, including the discernment of the role of SCA in the government's and the Church's goals for the youth. Moments of reflection and sharing will also be given emphasis to make time for integration and deepening. The formation is mostly workshop in form. Facilitators guide the participants together on a face-to-face basis. Space for games and activities is also needed. Tables for the working sessions are best appreciated. It is also very important to have a place for prayers.

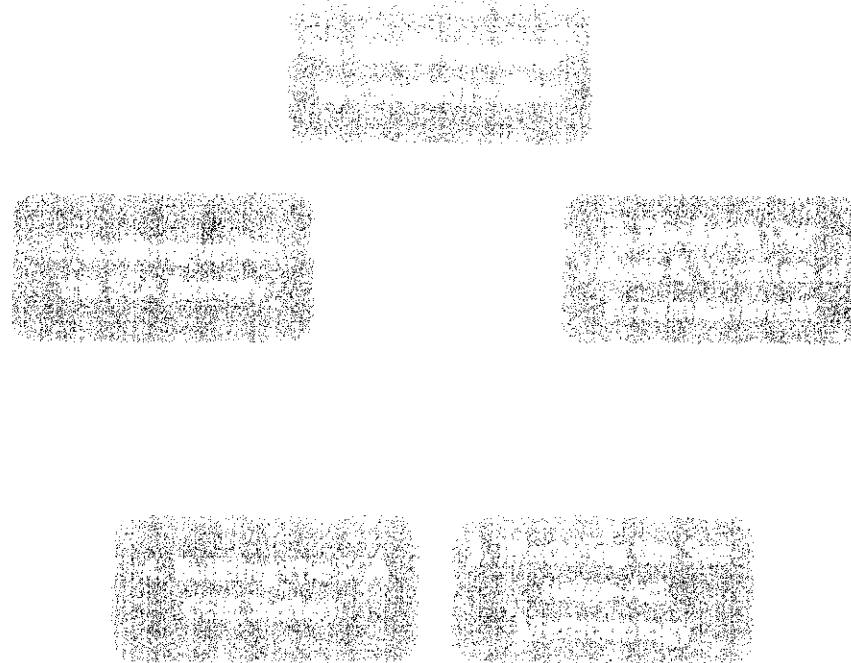
