2024 PATROL/CREW LEADERS TRAINING COURSES

1. The Bohol Council, Boy Scouts of the Philippines is announcing the conduct of the Patrol/Crew Leaders Training Courses on the respective venues and dates:

 Roxas Park, Calma, Garcia-Hernandez, Bohol - April 12-14, 2024 2. Pilar Central Elementary School, Pilar, Bohol - April 12-14, 2024 - April 12-14, 2024 3. Tagum Sur ES, Trinidad I District 4. Panglao Central Elementary School, Panglao - April 19-21, 2024 5. Getafe II Central ES, Tulang, Getafe, Bohol - April 19-21, 2024 6. Anda Central Elementary School - April 19-21, 2024 - April 19-21, 2024 7. Loon North Central Elementary School

2. The training aims to equip our boy leaders with useful life & leadership skills that they could share with their fellow scouts and for them also to comply with the requirements of the new advancement scheme. This is also to provide an opportunity for the unit leaders to be oriented with the new advancement scheme in senior scouting.

- 3. Qualified to participate are duly registered Boy and Senior Scouts from ages 10 18 years old. Accompanying adults must be with at least 2 years experience as a unit leader.
- 4. Other scouting districts may send their potential scouts to their most accessible venue but shall abide the maximum limit that shall be set by the host. Interested districts may also organize and conduct the course at their level on a date/schedule they found to be fitting for them as long as it falls on a weekend.
- 5. A registration fee of Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (P250.00) will be charged for each participant for the cost of training materials and other expenses including food provision of the training staff. Registration, transportation, and other expenses related to participation can be charged to the MOOE, SEF, School/District Scouting Funds, or any other available local school funds in accordance with the existing accounting and auditing guidelines.
- 6. Service Credits/Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) will be granted to all involved scouters/teachers and administrators in accordance with the existing rules and regulations.
- 7. We reiterate that the safety of the participating scouts should be given emphasis on the duration of the training. Participating scouts must all have their respective parents' approval.
- 8. Host/conducting districts then shall coordinate with the council for the training staff composition and other matters related to the training.
