Republic Act No. 10072 or the "Philippine Red Cross Act of 2009" Sec 6 stated that Membership in the Philippine Red Cross shall be open to all population regardless of citizenship. Furthermore, the usual contribution per student and teacher is Php10.00 but an option to avail the membership with accidental assistance benefit (MAAB) with classic membership for students at Php60.00 and silver membership for teachers at Php300.00. 
