Guidelines for Presentation:

1. Finalists should wear formal or smart casual attire.
2. Must be in the venue 30 minutes before start of the program.
3. Must submit electronic copy of presentation on or before September 05, 2024.
4. Presentation should be compatible with Windows PC. If using a Macintosh, should bring an adapter and own PC in case.
5. Each presenter is given 7 minutes to present research.
6. Questions from the judges to follow the presentation.
7. Decision of the Judges is final and unappealable.

Criteria for judging Final presentation:


1. Answers to question and assessment of knowledge. (10%)
2. Audiovisual presentation or aid (10%)
3. Diction, Clarity, on time delivery of presentation (10%)
4. Stage presence, energy, charisma, appeal (10%)
5. Relevance of Research to Public Health or the NUHRA (10%)
6. Follows systematic and appropriate research methodology. (20%)
7. Uses proper data analysis methods (10%)
8. Manuscript well-written and easily understood. (20%)
