4. In view of DepEd's policy on non-disruption of classes, the school heads of the teacher-advisers concerned shall ensure that somebody could take charge of the classes that will be left by the teachers during their attendance to the Environment Youth Forum with their student leader.

The Provincial Government of Bohol will provide meals and snacks for all participants throughout the forum. We believe this event will be a valuable learning experience and encourage their active participation.

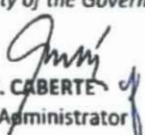
