1. In response to the communication sent from the Provincial Governor Hon. Erico Aristotle C. Aumentado through the Center for the Culture and Arts Development (CCAD) and in partnership with Bohol Arts and Cultural Heritage (BACH), this office supports the conduct of a three-day live-out workshop on “Atong Sayaw 2024” on **October 26-28, 2024 at the Bohol Cultural Center, Tagbilaran City**
2. This activity aims to:
 - a.) upskill learners, teacher-coaches with the knowledge and skill-sets of the Fundamentals of Folk Dance;
 - b.) forge camaraderie and networking among MAPEH teachers and Folkdance enthusiasts in the province;
 - c.) encourage teachers, learners, dance enthusiasts and other stakeholders in the dance community to take part in the programs of the Provincial Government of Bohol.
3. **The participants are identified learners, 1 couple/pair (1 male and 1 female) and a teacher-coach per Municipality. It is expected that the 47 Municipalities will send three (3) participants.** The teacher-coach must ensure that the parents will issue a parental consent for their children to participate in this activity. This parental consent will be saved through this link: <https://tinyurl.com/AtongSayaw24> **not later than October 24, 2024.** The school heads of the participating schools are instructed to make sure that a relieving teacher/s will handle the classes of the teacher-coaches on October 28, 2024, (Monday).
4. This is a live-out activity. Transportation, foods, accommodation and incidental expenses are chargeable against the school MOOE or other local funds subject to the usual government accounting rules and regulations.

3. 3rd District – 20 pairs and coaches

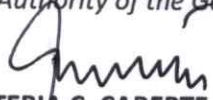
