STRENGTHENING OFFICE AND SCHOOL RESILIENCE

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Region and Division DRRM Coordinators
All Others Concerned

1. This month, the onset of the Northeast Monsoon is expected, with most typhoons tracked passing through Central Visayas, particularly the Northern part of Cebu. Data indicates that one of the highest recorded incidents in our region is classroom damaged caused by falling trees during strong winds or typhoons.
2. In view thereof, this Office, directs all Division Offices to intensify further the following disaster preparedness measures to their respective schools within their area of responsibility:
 - a. Pruning trees.
 - b. Clearing gutters and removing debris.
 - c. Ensure that all school infrastructure, including drainage systems, are inspected and maintained to prevent water accumulation and flooding.
 - d. Monitor weather reports regularly from official sources.
 - e. Secure loose objects and outdoor materials that may become hazards in high winds.
 - f. Review and update contingency plans, evacuation maps, and communication protocols.
